Atto Walls

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Bud Connolly

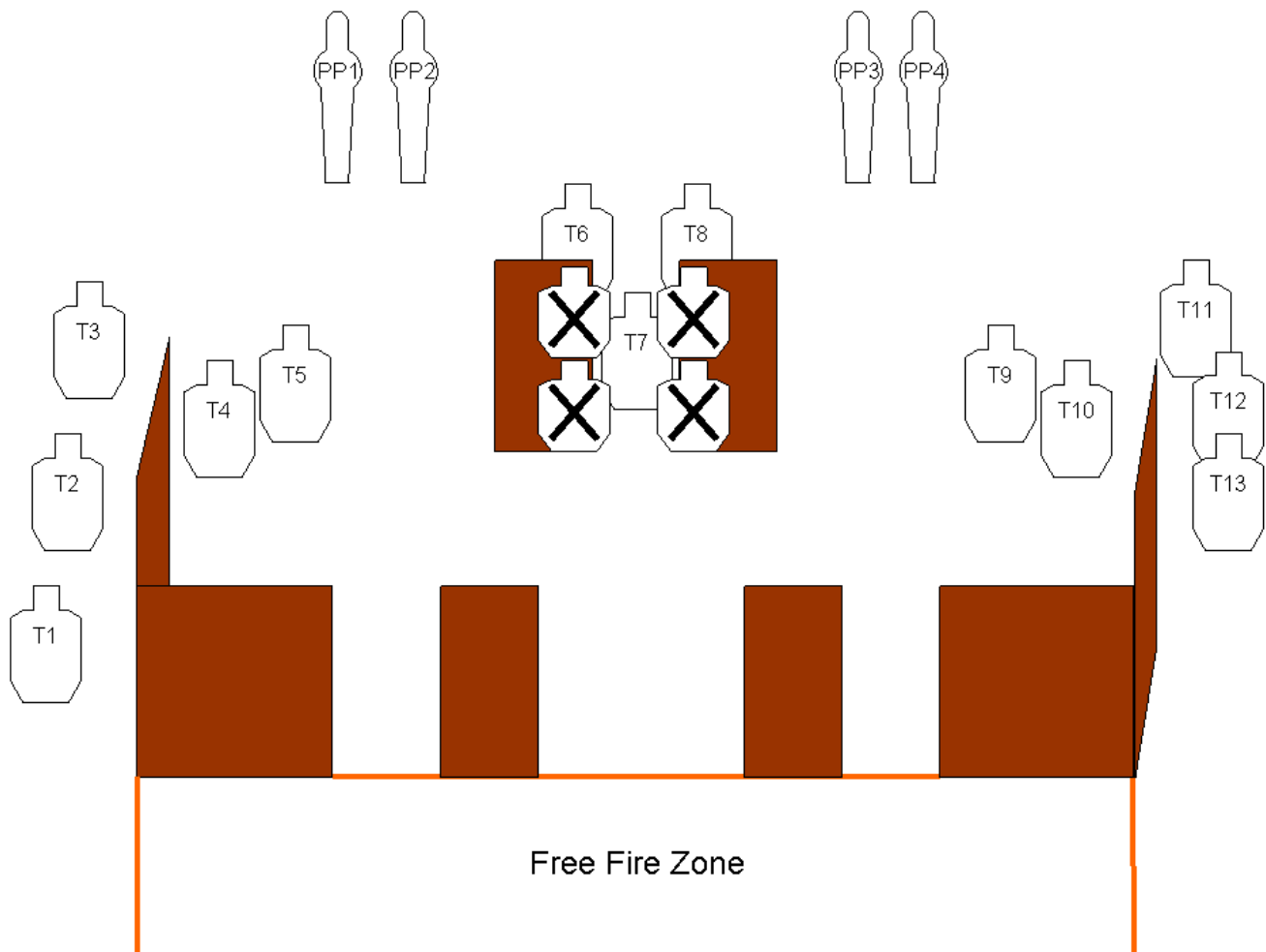
START POSITION: Both hands on corner of wall in Free Fire Zone. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in Rule 8.1.1 or 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal, draw and engage T1-T13 with two (2) rounds each and knock down PP1-PP4 as and when visible. One Procedural per shot fired while faulting the line. Match DQ for engaging PP1-PP4 with both feet faulting the line.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 30 rounds, 150 points
TARGETS: 13 IPSC, 4 PP
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
No-shoot hit. -10
Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: Place Atto Walls so that T6-T8 can not be engaged from any one position. Adjust (depth) T6-T8 so as not to block PP1-PP4 from the center opening. Angle the Atto Walls in front of T6-T8 as necessary. Caution Tape may be strung across the wall openings. Adjust T11-T13 to avoid shoot thru to Stage 2.

RO NOTES: Watch for Foot Faults.
