Answer the Door

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Matthew Birch

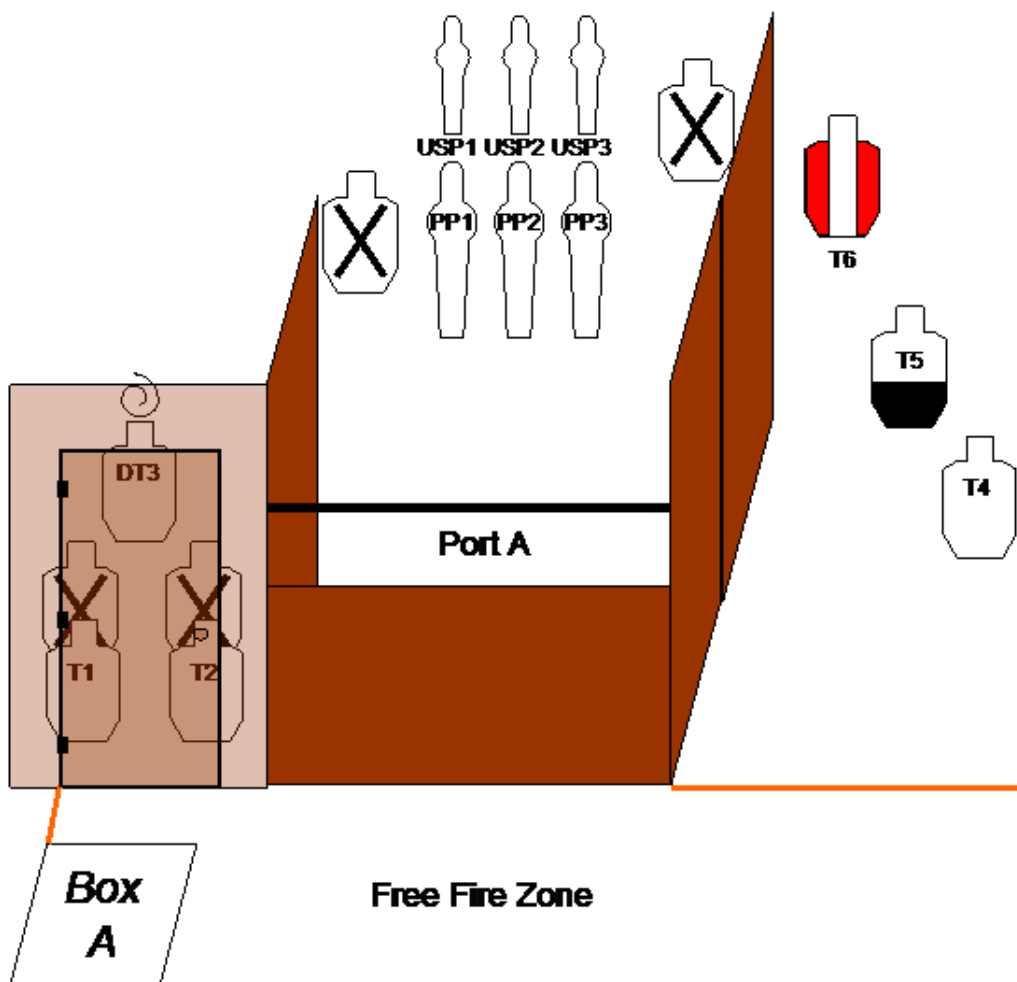
START POSITION: Standing in Box with hands relaxed at sides. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in Rule 8.1.1 or 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal draw and engage T1-T6 with two (2) rounds each and knock down PP1-PP3 and USP1-USP3. The left and right sides of T6 is a No Shoot. Door threshold is a Fault Line. One Procedural per shot fired while faulting any line.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 18 rounds, 90 points
TARGETS: 6 IPSC, 3 PP, 3 USP
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
 No-shoot hit. -10
 Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: Place PP1-PP3 directly in front of USP1-USP3. PP1-PP3 are 7 yards from Port A, centered in the port and spaced no more than 6" apart. T1, T2 & DT3 are placed at the end of wall and centered in the door opening. Hard Cover on T5 is up to the bottom of the "A" mark and on T6, cover the C and D zones on both sides. Minimize the width of T4-T6. Place stage to far right of bay and right in front of shooting bench to allow room for Stage 1 to the left.

RO NOTES: Watch for sweeping when opening door and Foot faults.
