START POSITION: Standing in Box A with hands relaxed at sides. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 or 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal, draw and engage targets as they become visible from within the Fault Lines. T7-T10 may be engaged from Box A.

PP4 activates swinger T6.

Steel plate in front of Texas Star is Hard Cover only.

All walls extend vertically to infinity.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 29 rounds, 145 points


TARGETS: 10 IPSC, 4 PP, 5 Plates

SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A

START-STOP: Audible - Last shot **PENALTIES:** Procedural. -10

No-shoot hit. -10

Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: PP3 & PP4 can be seen from left side and from left chamber. T1-T3 are angled towards Box A and No Shoot is set to force shooter to go left of the wall. T4 & T5 are set up next to barrel. Barrel also guards splash from PP4. Second barrel hides swinger T6. T6 activator is placed on the ground behind PP4 to delay activation. All walls are set no more than 7' above ground. Rear Fault Line is 10 yards from Texas Star, PP3 & PP4.

RO NOTES: Watch for foot faults.
