Stage 4 Pull Toy

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition COURSE DESIGNER: Bud Connolly

START POSITION: Standing in Box A with pull string in Strong hand. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 or 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On start signal, pull string to activate Drop Out T4, then draw and engage T1-T12 with two (2) rounds each and knock down PP1-PP3. T9-T12 must be engaged through the port. Targets may be engaged from either Box A or Area B.

SCORING


SCORING: Comstock, 27 rounds, 135 points

TARGETS: 12 IPSC, 3 PP

SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A

START-STOP: Audible - Last shot PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
No-shoot hit. -10

Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: Set up arrays to minimize the number of targets visible from any one location. Port is created by setting walls ~2' apart and stapling ground cloth to wall leaving a port opening from 4' to 5' above the ground. Set PP2 & PP3 in far right corner of the bay. Back wall and fault line are 8 yards from PP1-PP3. Use No Shoots or a section of soft wall to block T7-T8 and PP2-PP3 from left side of Area B.

RO NOTES: Watch for foot faults.
