START POSITION: Standing in Box A with hands relaxed at sides. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 or 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On start signal, draw and engage Plate P1 from Box A. Then engage T1-T11 with two (2) rounds each, as and when visible.

SCORING


SCORING: Comstock, 23 rounds, 115 points

TARGETS: 11 IPSC, 1 Plate

SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A

START-STOP: Audible - Last shot **PENALTIES:** Procedural. -10 No-shoot hit. -10

Miss. -10





SETUP NOTES: P1 is a knock down plate set behind two large square plates (hard cover only) set so that it can only be engaged from Box A. T5-T8 are set on 3' sticks and hidden behind the barrels. T9-T11 are set on 5' sticks and No Shoot covers the bottom of T11 to the middle of the A zone.

RO NOTES: Watch the 180° as shooter passes T1-T4 and T5-T6.
