START POSITION: Standing with heels on marks and hands relaxed at sides. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 or 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On Start Signal, draw and engage targets as visible from within the Fault Lines. Engaging the Texas Star while both feet are faulting the forward Fault Line will result in a Match DQ.



SETUP NOTES: T1 can be shot from either the left or middle. T6 can be shot from either the right or middle. T2-T5 are only visible from their respective ends. The Texas Star is only visible from the middle and is set at 8 yards from the forward fault line.
