START POSITION: Standing in Box A with hands hanging naturally at sides. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 or 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On start signal, draw and engage PP1-PP3 and USP1-USP3 from Box A ONLY.

Engaging Steel with **both feet** outside of Box A will result in a **Match DQ**. Otherwise, normal Foot Faults apply.

Then engage T1-T9 from within the Fault Lines or Box A.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 24 rounds, 120 points




SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A
