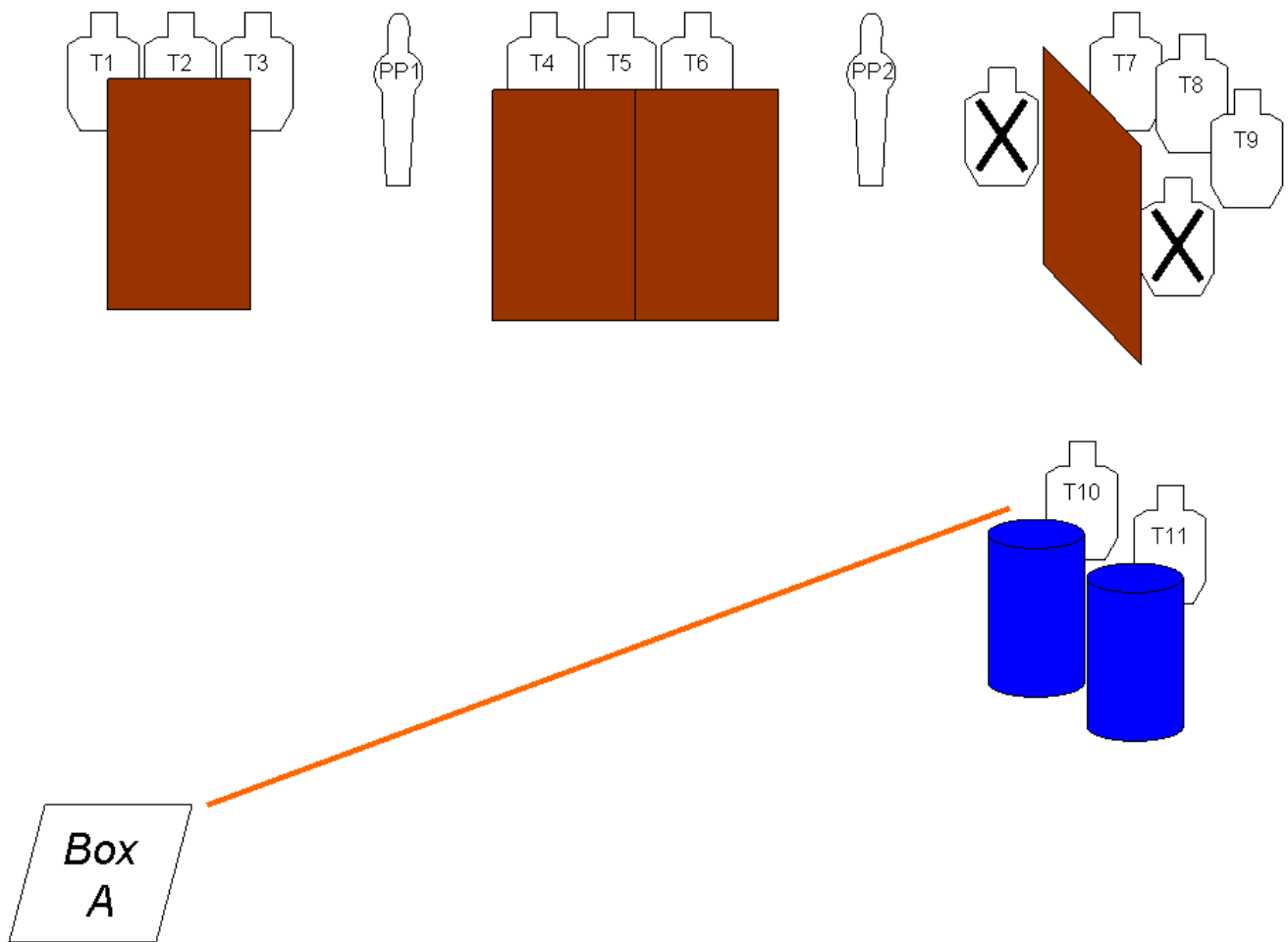

| START POSITION: Standing in Box A with hands relaxed at sides. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 or 8.1.2. | |
| <p>STAGE PROCEDURE</p> <p>On start signal, draw and engage T1-T11 and PP-1-PP2 from behind the Fault Line or in Box A.</p> | <p>SCORING</p> <p>SCORING: Comstock, 24 rounds, 120 points</p> <p>TARGETS: 11 IPSC, 2 PP</p> <p>SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A</p> <p>START-STOP: Audible - Last shot</p> <p>PENALTIES: Procedural. -10 No-shoot hit. -10 Miss. -10</p> |
