# Inside Star

**RULES:** Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition    **COURSE DESIGNER:** Bud Connolly

**START POSITION:** Standing in Box A with hands relaxed at sides. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 or 8.1.2.

### STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal, move from Box A and engage PP1-PP6 and Texas Star from behind the Fault Line.

**Engaging the steel with both feet faulting the line will result in a Match DQ.**

### SCORING

**SCORING:** Comstock, 11 rounds, 55 points

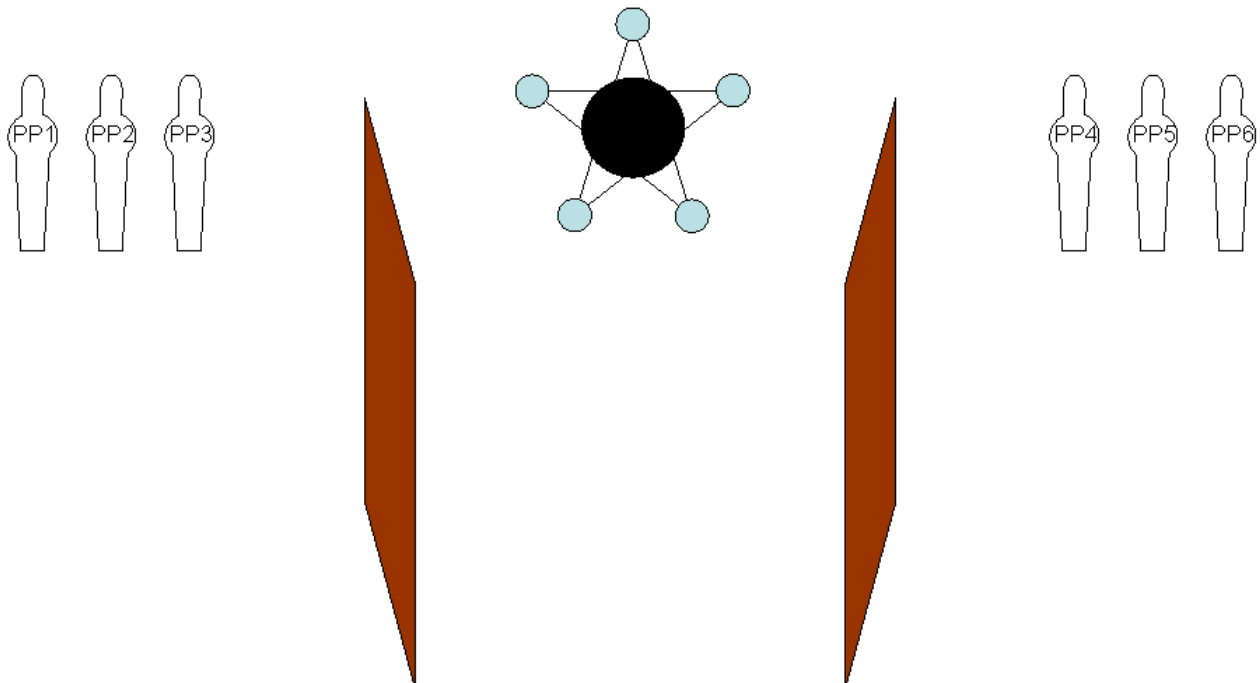
**TARGETS:** 6 PP, 5 Plates

**SCORED HITS:** Steel down = 1A

**START-STOP:** Audible - Last shot

**PENALTIES:** Procedural. -10

**SETUP NOTES:** Setup first in north end of East Bay (cover). Texas Star is 8 yards from Fault Line and as close to back berm as possible. Set walls far enough apart to force shooter to move. May add 'wings' to front of wall.

**RO NOTES:** Watch for Foot Faults.
