Barrel 22

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Bud Connolly

START POSITION: Standing behind barrel with both hands grasping the barrel on marks. Handgun is unloaded and placed on top of barrel with muzzle pointing downrange. First magazine or speedloader may be placed on top of barrel.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal, retrieve handgun and engage T1-T10 with two (2) rounds each and knock down PP1 & PP2.

PP1 activates swinger T7.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 22 rounds, 110 points

TARGETS: 10 IPSC, 2 PP

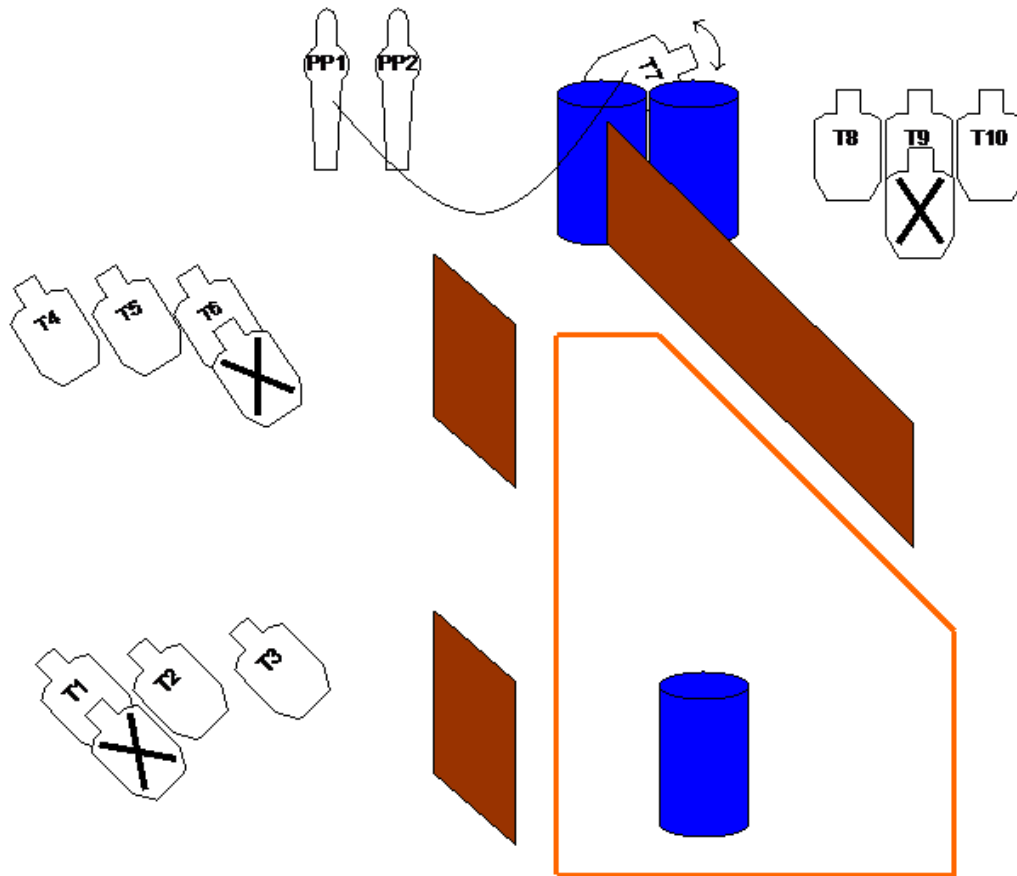
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A

START-STOP: Audible - Last shot

PENALTIES: Procedural. -10

No-shoot hit. -10

Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: Setup in Left Bay on Left side. Adjust Fault Line and fence on right side to ensure all shots on T8-T10 are straight down range. PP1 & PP2 are 8 yards from forward Fault Line and swinger T7 is at least 3 yards in front of steel.

RO NOTES: Watch for Foot Faults.
