Over a Barrel

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Bud Connolly

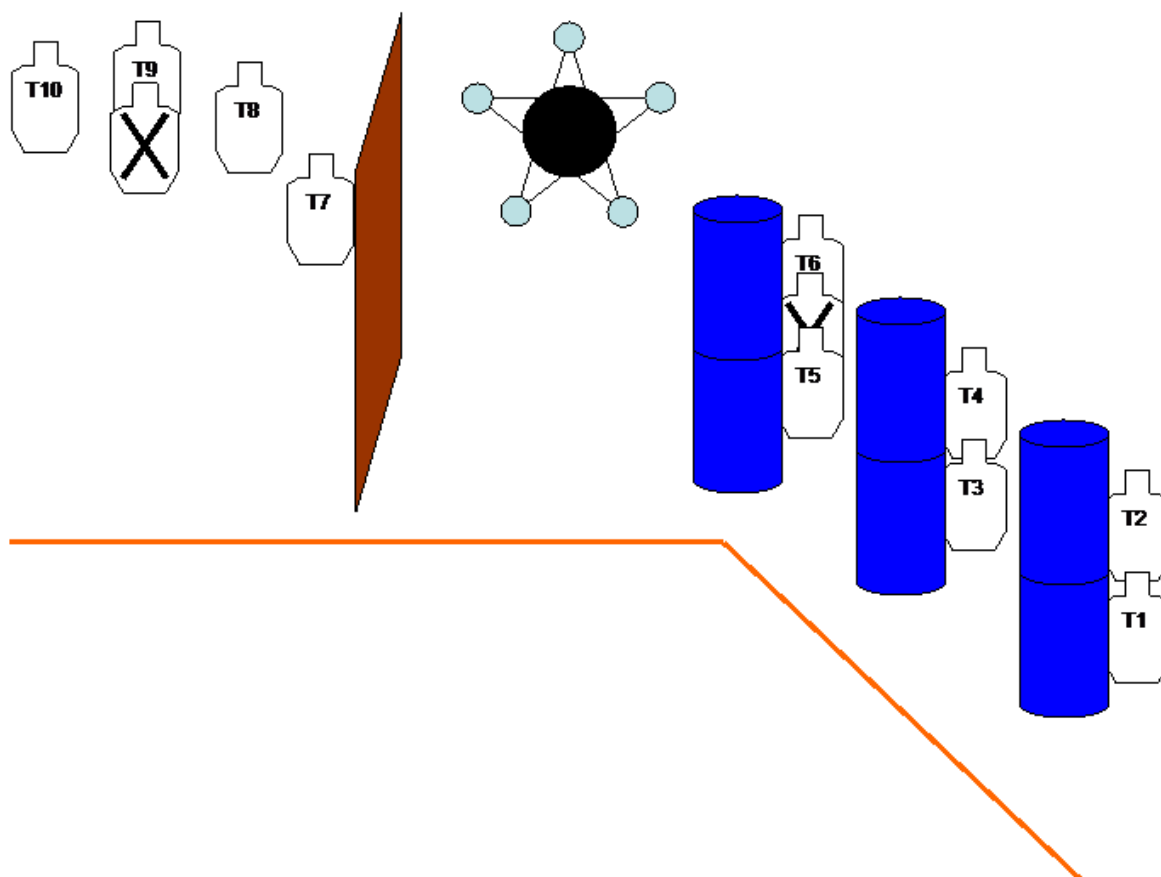
START POSITION: Standing with Right Foot against the end of the Fault line and arms crossed in front of chest.
Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 or 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal, draw and engage T1-T10 with two (2) rounds each and knock down five (5) steel plates.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 25 rounds, 125 points
TARGETS: 10 IPSC, 5 Plates
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
No-shoot hit. -10
Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: Setup in Right Bay on the Right side.
T1&T2 are right against berm. Angle T4-T6 slightly to
hide Texas Star in the corner. Texas Star is 8 yards from
forward Fault Line. Fault Line is back from walls and
barrels at least 3'.

RO NOTES: Watch for Foot Faults.
