



PP1 activates swinger T8 and PP5 activates swinger T7.





Leave room in front of targets to paste. T9-T12 are set on 3' sticks along the right berm. Leave 3' between Fault Lines and walls. Setup as tight to right as possible to allow room for Stage 3.

**RO NOTES**: Watch for Foot Faults and ensure that T5-T8 are engaged through the port.
