# Front Sight

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition COURSE DESIGNER: P.R. Metcalf—Modification by US Design Team

**START POSITION:** Standing in Box A, boths arms hanging relaxed at sides or both wrists above respective shoulders shooter's choice. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 and 8.1.2.

## STAGE PROCEDURE

String 1. Start facing uprange. Upon start signal, turn, from Box A engage T1-T3 with only two rounds per target.

String 2. Start facing targets, hand position opposite of string one, upon start signal, from Box A, engage T1-T3 with only two rounds per target.




**SETUP NOTES:** Set paper targets to 5 feet high at shoulders. Box A is 3 feet by 3 feet. Angle T1 and T3 to face shooting box.



Stage 2 Angles

START POSITION: Standing in Box A with hands relaxed at sides. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 or 8.1.2.

**SETUP NOTES**: Setup in Right Corner of the Left Pistol Bay first. Set T4-T6 so that they can be engaged only from front right corner and set T7-T9 to be engaged from left corner only. T10-T12 are set against the right berm on short sticks. T1-T3 set on tall sticks so shots will impact into back berm.

**RO NOTES**: Watch for Foot Faults.

Stage 3 Left Corner

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition COURSE DESIGNER: Bud Connolly

**START POSITION:** Standing in Box A with hands relaxed at sides. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 or 8.1.2.

#### STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal, draw and engage T1-T8 with two (2) rounds each and knock down PP1 & PP2.

#### **SCORING**


**SCORING:** Comstock, 18 rounds, 90 points

TARGETS: 8 IPSC, 2 PP

**SCORED HITS:** Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A

**START-STOP:** Audible - Last shot **PENALTIES:** Procedural. -10

No-shoot hit. -10 Miss. -10



**SETUP NOTES**: Setup stage 4 in the Right corner of the Right bay first. Keep Fault Lines ~3' from fence. Set T6-T8 down at end of the fence but not visible from the left corner Fault Line. Left fence line is only long enough to cover T1-T3 and block T4 & PP1 from view.

**RO NOTES**: Watch for Foot Faults.

# **Hide & Seek**

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition COURSE DESIGNER: Bud Connolly

**START POSITION:** Standing in Box A with hands relaxed at sides. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 or 8.1.2.

#### STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal, draw and engage T1-T3 with two (2) rounds each from Box A. Move to Area B and engage T7-T9 with two (2) rounds each from Area B. Move from Area B and engage T4-T6 with two (2) rounds each through the port.

#### SCORING


**SCORING:** Comstock, 18 rounds, 90 points


**TARGETS:** 9 IPSC


**SCORED HITS:** Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A


**START-STOP:** Audible - Last shot **PENALTIES:** Procedural. -10

No-shoot hit. -10 Miss. -10









**SETUP NOTES:** Setup first in Right bay and keep firing angles straight back to back berm. Place barrels far enough in front of targets to force shooter to use both sides of the shooting box/area. Set T4-T6 down low against back berm. Keep the distances between shooting area short!

**RO NOTES**: Watch for Foot Faults.
