RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition COURSE DESIGNER: Bud Connolly

START POSITION: Standing in Box A with hands relaxed at sides. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 or 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal, draw and engage T1-T3 with two (2) rounds each from Box A. Move to Area B and engage T7-T9 with two (2) rounds each from Area B. Move from Area B and engage T4-T6 with two (2) rounds each through the port.

SCORING


SCORING: Comstock, 18 rounds, 90 points


TARGETS: 9 IPSC


SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A

START-STOP: Audible - Last shot **PENALTIES:** Procedural. -10

No-shoot hit. -10 Miss. -10









SETUP NOTES: Setup first in Right bay and keep firing angles straight back to back berm. Place barrels far enough in front of targets to force shooter to use both sides of the shooting box/area. Set T4-T6 down low against back berm. Keep the distances between shooting area short!

RO NOTES: Watch for Foot Faults.
