START POSITION: Standing on either end of shooting area with heels on marks and hands relaxed at sides. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 or 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal, draw and engage T1-T4 with two (2) rounds each and knock down PP1-PP6

SCORING


SCORING: Comstock, 14 rounds, 70 points

TARGETS: 4 IPSC, 6 PP

SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A

START-STOP: Audible - Last shot PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
No-shoot hit. -10

Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: Use the wall with a port. Use orange fence to close off the center section of the port as shown. Shooting area is set 3' away from wall. Pepper Poppers are set at 8 yards and 10 yards from wall. Center wall extends far enough to prevent engaging targets from both sides.

RO NOTES: Watch for Foot Faults.
