RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Bud Connolly

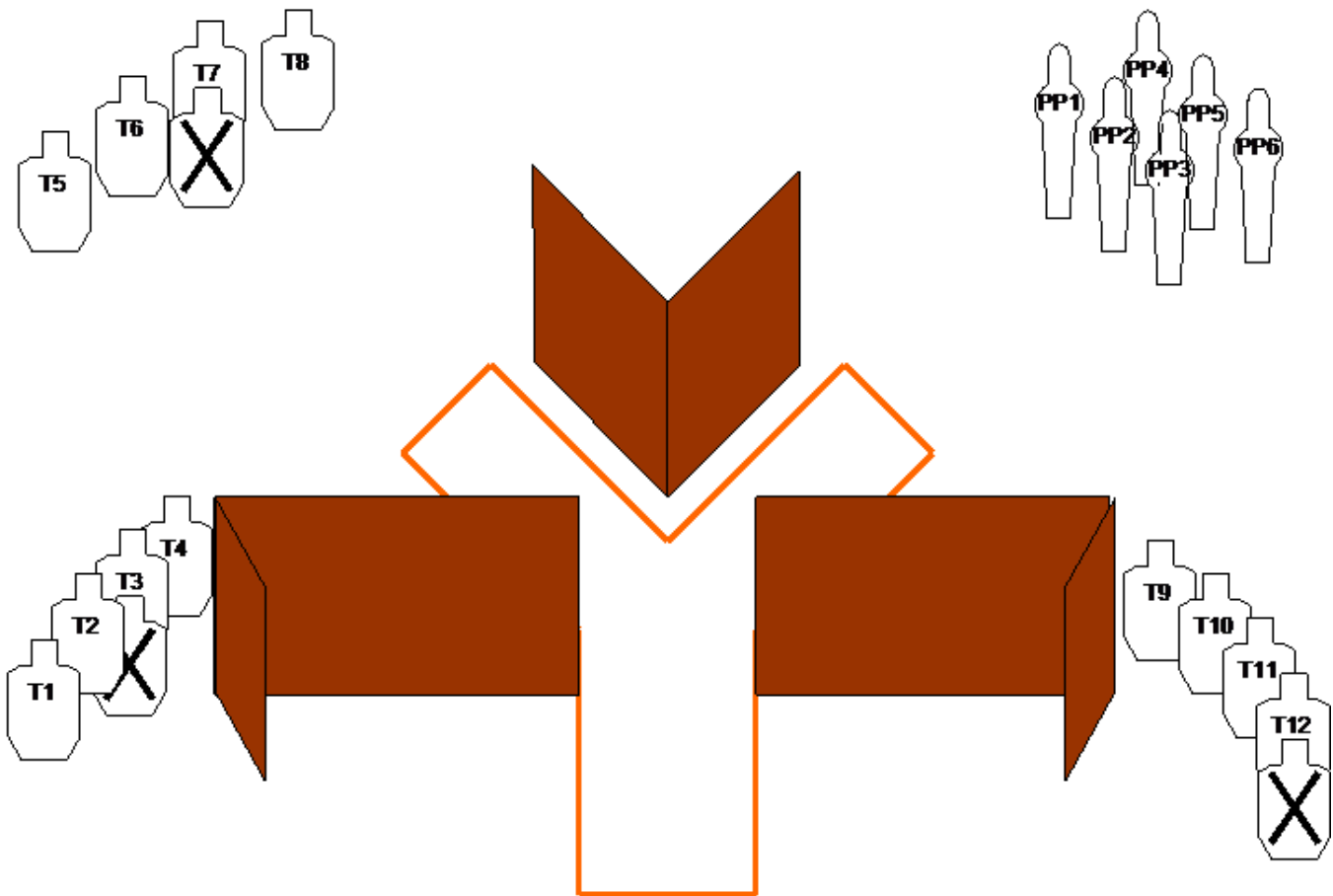
START POSITION: Standing with heels against rear Fault Line and hands relaxed at sides. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 or 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal, draw and engage T1-T12 with two (2) rounds each and knock down PP1-PP6.
Shooter must remain within the Shooting Area during the course of fire. One procedural for each step outside of the Shooting Area.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 30 rounds, 150 points
TARGETS: 12 IPSC, 6 PP
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
No-shoot hit. -10
Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: Walls are only a vision barrier and to prevent 180° violations. Walls are not to scale or necessarily in the proper position on the diagram. Shooting Area should be no longer than 10 yards.

RO NOTES: Watch for Foot Faults and count the steps.
