Popper Star

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Bud Connolly

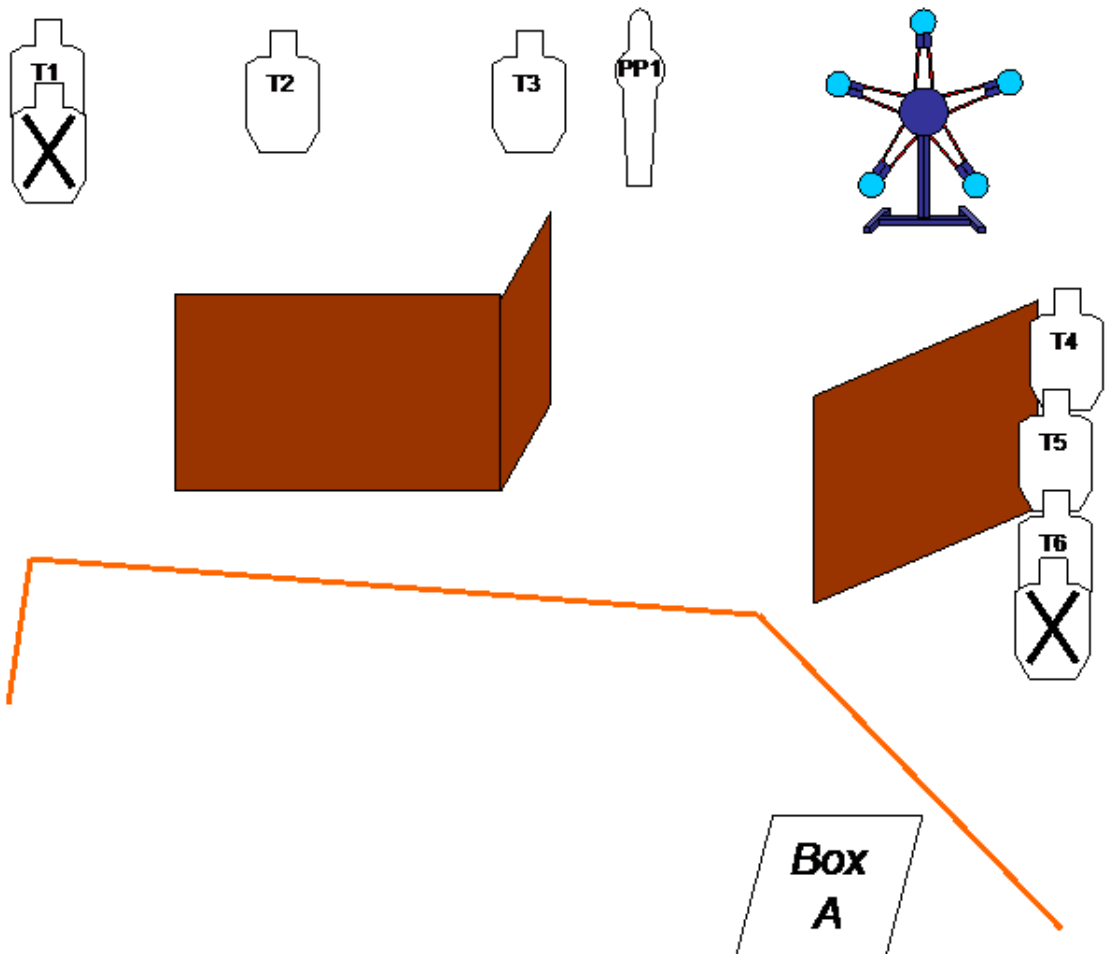
START POSITION: Standing in Box with hands relaxed at sides. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 or 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal, draw and engage T1-T6 with two (2) rounds each and knock down PP1 and Plates P1-P5.
Box A is part of the shooting area.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 18 rounds, 90 points
TARGETS: 6 IPSC, 1 PP, 5 Plates
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
No-shoot hit. -10
Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: Set Texas Star in corner and 8 yards from Fault Line. T4-T6 are set on 3' sticks against right side berm. Right wall is set to prevent direct line to Texas Star from Box A. T3 can be engaged from center opening or left end.

RO NOTES: Watch for Foot Faults.
