Star Port

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Bud Connolly

START POSITION: Standing with toes on marks and hands relaxed at sides. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 or 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal, draw and engage T1-T12 with two (2) rounds each and knock down Plates 1-5.

Faulting the forward Fault Line with both feet while engaging Plates 1-5 will result in a Match DQ.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 29 rounds, 145 points

TARGETS: 12 IPSC, 5 Plates

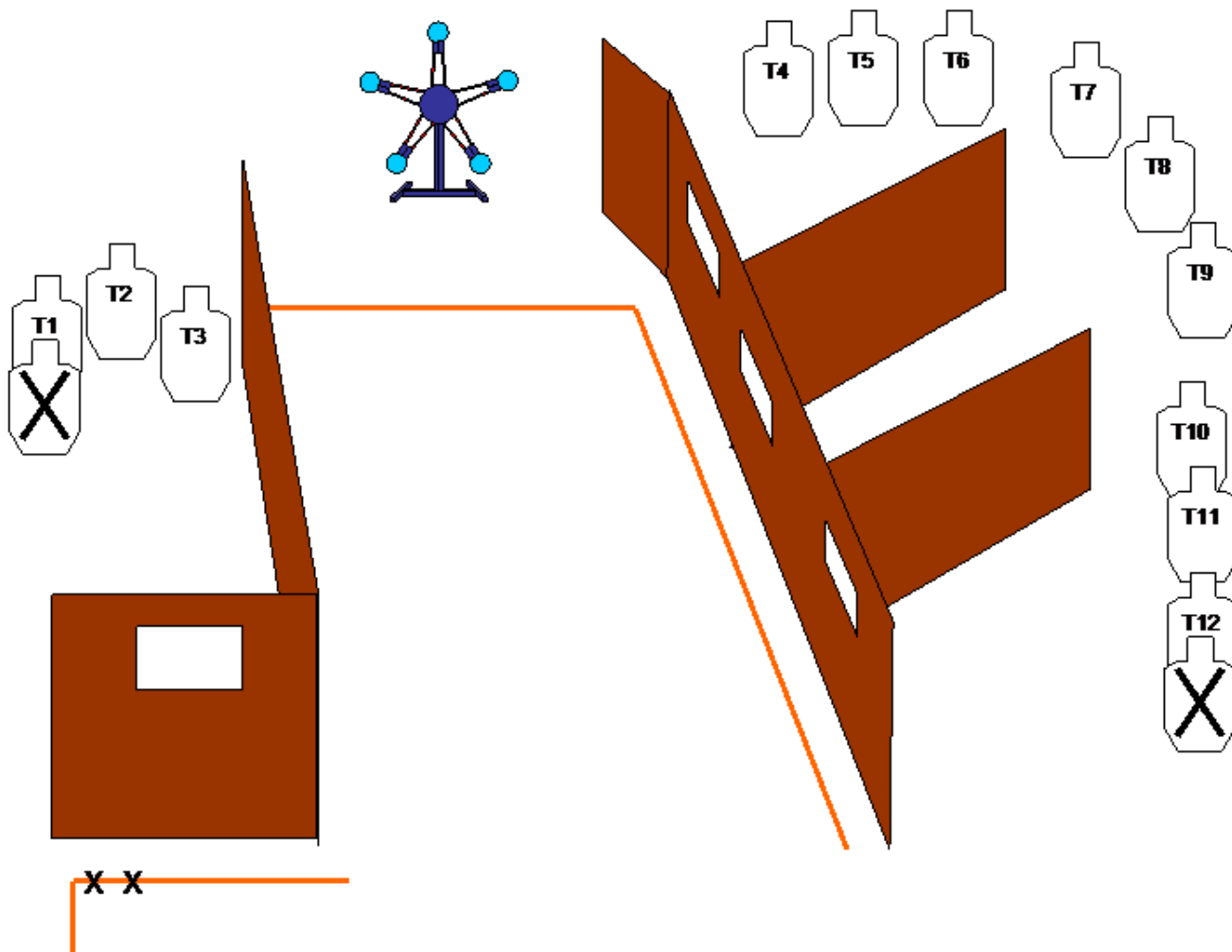
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A

START-STOP: Audible - Last shot

PENALTIES: Procedural. -10

No-shoot hit. -10

Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: Wing Walls on right side can be either No Shoots or Atto Walls to block the vision of at least one target in other arrays from each port. Set Fault Lines at least 3' from walls. Set Texas Star 8 yards from forward Fault Line. Left port wall is back from first right port by at least 3 yards (prevent 180's!!!). Watch 180 when setting targets in the right side ports.

RO NOTES: Watch for Foot Faults.
