

**SETUP NOTES**: T3 & T8 can be engaged from the middle or the respective end position. T1, T2, T9 & T10 can only be engaged from the respective end position. Set targets tall enough to ensure bullets will strike the berm.

**START POSITION:** Standing in Box A, reaching overhead for a box, arms fully extended over head, elbows locked. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 and 8.1.2.

#### **STAGE PROCEDURE**


String 1. Upon start signal, from Box A engage T1-T3 with only two rounds per target, then make a mandatory reload and from Box A engage T1-T3 with only two rounds per target using strong hand only.


String 2. Upon start signal, from Box A engage T1-T3 with only two rounds per target, then make a mandatory reload and from Box A engage T1-T3 with only two rounds per target using weak hand only.

Jams may be cleared with both hands.

#### SCORING

SCORING: Virginia Count, 24 rounds, 120 points TARGETS: 3 IPSC SCORED HITS: Best 8/paper START - STOP: Audible - Last shot PENALTIES: Per current edition USPSA Practical Shooting Handbook. Failure to perform mandatory reload will result in one procedural penalty per shot fired. Strings must be shot in order prescribed or one procedural will be assesed.





<b>START POSITION:</b> Standing behind rear Fault line. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 or 8.1.2.			
<b>STAGE PROCEDURE</b> On signal, draw and engage T1-T8 with one (1) round each. Move to next Fault Line and re-engage T1-T8 with one (1) round each. Repeat for last two Fault Lines. Failure to move up as required will result in one Procedural Penalty per shot fired. 

**SETUP NOTES**: Left Fault Line is 10' down from Right Fault Line. All Fault Lines are 4' from any wall. T9 & T10 are set parallel against the right side berm. There is a No-shoot in front of T7. Use Atto Walls on the opening/ends on Rear Wall. RO NOTES: Watch for Foot Faults.
