RULES: USPSA Rule Book, Current Edition

COURSE DESIGNER: 2007 1911 Design Team

START POSITION: Standing, facing down range. Wrists above respective shoulders. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 and 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE

- String 1: On signal, engage one target with only six rounds freestyle, make a mandatory reload and engage another target with only six rounds strong hand unsupported.
- String 2: On signal, engage one target with only six rounds freestyle, perform a mandatory reload and engage another target with only six rounds weak hand unsupported.


All rounds must be fired from within the shooting box.

SCORED HITS: Best 6/paper START - STOP: Audible - Last shot PENALTIES: Per current edition of USPSA Rule Book.





START POSITION: Standing in Box A with hands relaxed at sides. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 or 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE	SCORING	
On signal, draw and engage T1-T10 with two (2) rounds	SCORING:	Comstock, 23 rounds, 115 points
each and knock down PP1 – PP3.	TARGETS:	10 IPSC, 3 PP
PP3 activates Drop Turner T7 which disappears at rest.	SCORED HITS:	Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = $1A$
Mark any misses on T7 as No Penalty Mikes (NPM) and	START-STOP:	Audible - Last shot
total separately.	PENALTIES:	Procedural10
		No-shoot hit10

SETUP NOTES: Set targets to ensure that bullets will impact on berm. No shoot on DT7 is set at bottom of stand to help protect the stand. Expose at least all of D zone on No Shoot.



STAGE PROCEDURE On signal, draw and engage T1-T9 with two (2) rounds each.	TARGETS: SCORED HITS: START-STOP:			



SETUP NOTES: Setup in back of Right bay. T5 is visible from both of the center two ports.

RO NOTES: Watch for Foot Faults and 180 violations.



START POSITION: Standing in Box A with hands relaxed at sides. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 or 8.1.2.

and knock down P1-P5 and PP1.	TARGETS:	8 IPSC, 1 PP, 5 Plates	
	SCORED HITS:	Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = $1A$	
	START-STOP:	Audible - Last shot	
	PENALTIES:	Procedural10	
		No-shoot hit10	
		Miss10	



SETUP NOTES: Setup in south end of Right bay (Stage 3 is in the back (North) end of bay. Set T5 & T6 so that they must be engaged from the end of the shooting area and are not shoot throughs to Stage 3.

RO NOTES: Watch for Foot Faults.
