Stuck in the Middle

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Phil McKenzie & Bud Connolly

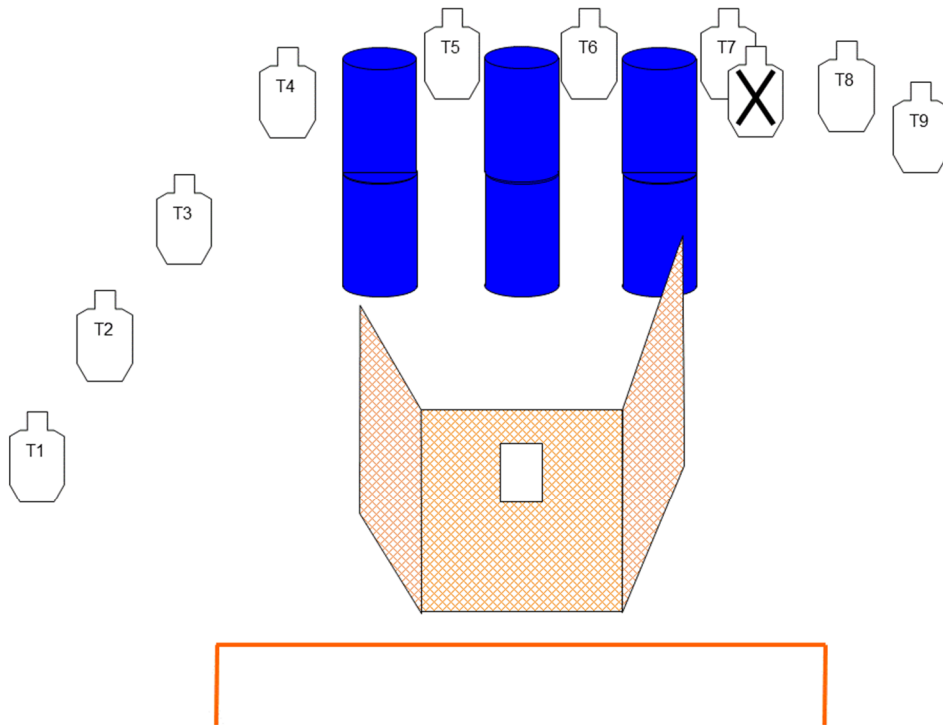
START POSITION: Standing in front of port with strong hand touching the port. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 or 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal, draw and engage T1-T9 with two (2) rounds each.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 18 rounds, 90 points
TARGETS: 9 IPSC
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
No-shoot hit. -10
Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: T1-T3 are only visible from the left side. T5 & T6 are only visible through the port and set back from barrels at least 3' to facilitate scoring and pasting. T8 & T9 are only visible from the right side. Adjust side walls as needed.

RO NOTES: None.

Stage 2

Star V

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Phil McKenzie

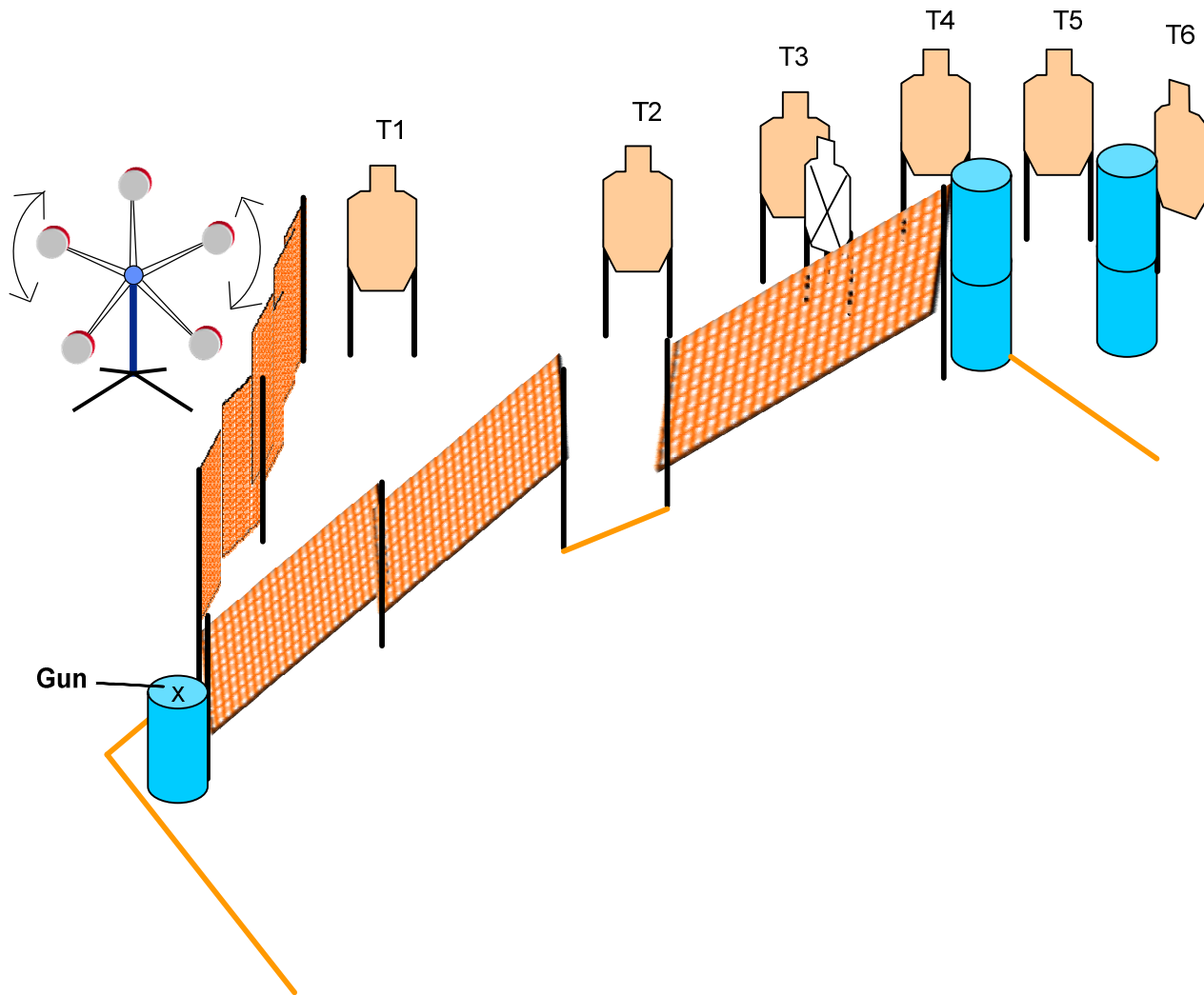
START POSITION: Standing outside of the shooting area with hands relaxed at sides. Handgun is loaded and placed on barrel with trigger guard over the mark.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal, enter shooting area and engage T1-T6 with two (2) rounds each and knock down plates P1-P5.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 17 rounds, 85 points
TARGETS: 6 IPSC, 5 Plates
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
No-shoot hit. -10
Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: Texas Star is set 10 yards from barrel.
Keep all Fault Lines at least 3' from any wall!

Stage 3

Long Shot

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Bud Connolly

START POSITION: Standing erect with heels on marks and hands relaxed at sides. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 or 8.1.2.

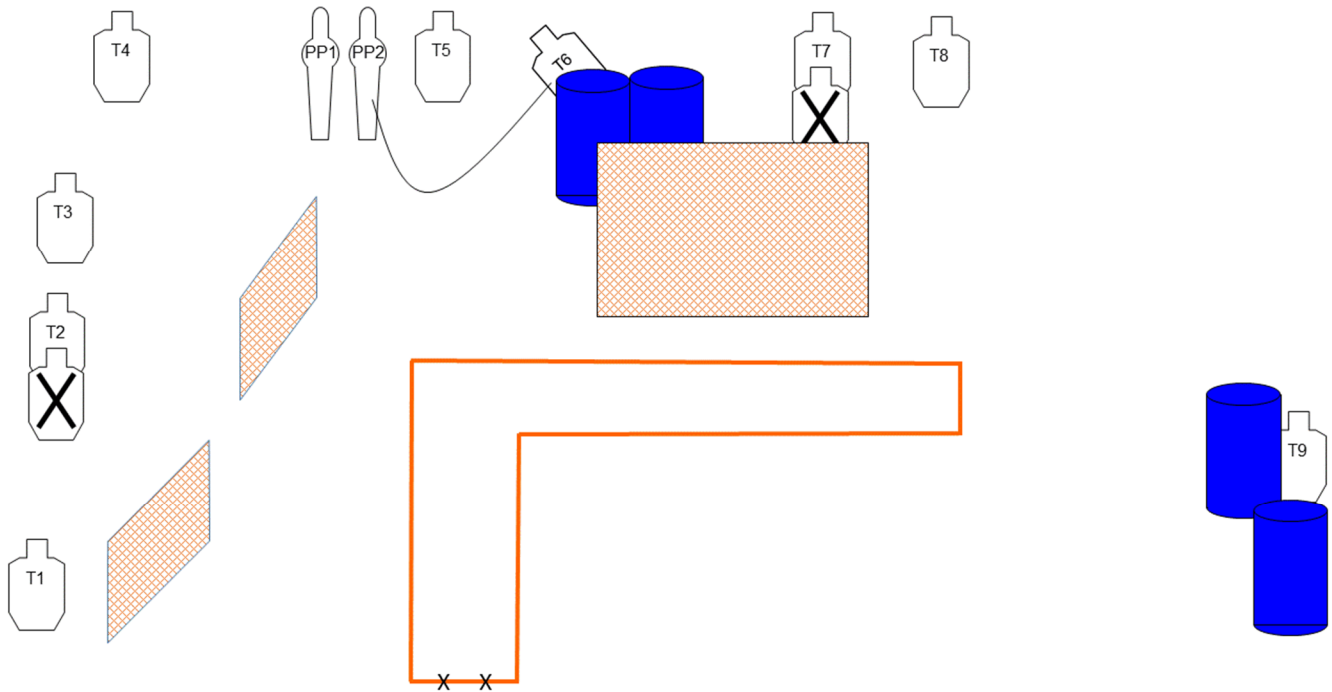
STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal, engage T1-T9 with two (2) rounds each and knock down PP1 & PP2.

PP2 activates swinger T6 which remains visible at rest.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 20 rounds, 100 points
TARGETS: 9 IPSC, 2 PP
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
 No-shoot hit. -10
 Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: PP1&2 are 8 yards from forward Fault Line. Far wall is set to require T8 be taken from the right end. Walls for T1 & T2 start on 180. T9 is on far right berm, low and between the two barrels. Remember, this is a 2-D drawing and not to scale!!! Stage 4 will be in the far right corner of the bay.

RO NOTES: Watch for Foot Faults.

Can You Count

RULES: USPSA Rule Book, Current Edition

COURSE DESIGNER: Mark Ramsey and John Golson

START POSITION: Standing erect in Box A, arms hanging naturally at sides. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 and 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal, from Box A only:

String 1: Engage T1 with five rounds only. Perform a mandatory reload and engage T2 with five rounds only.

String 2: Engage T3 with five rounds only. Perform a mandatory reload and engage T4 with five rounds only.

Targets within a string may be engaged in any order without penalty

SCORING

SCORING: Virginia Count, 20 rounds, 100 points

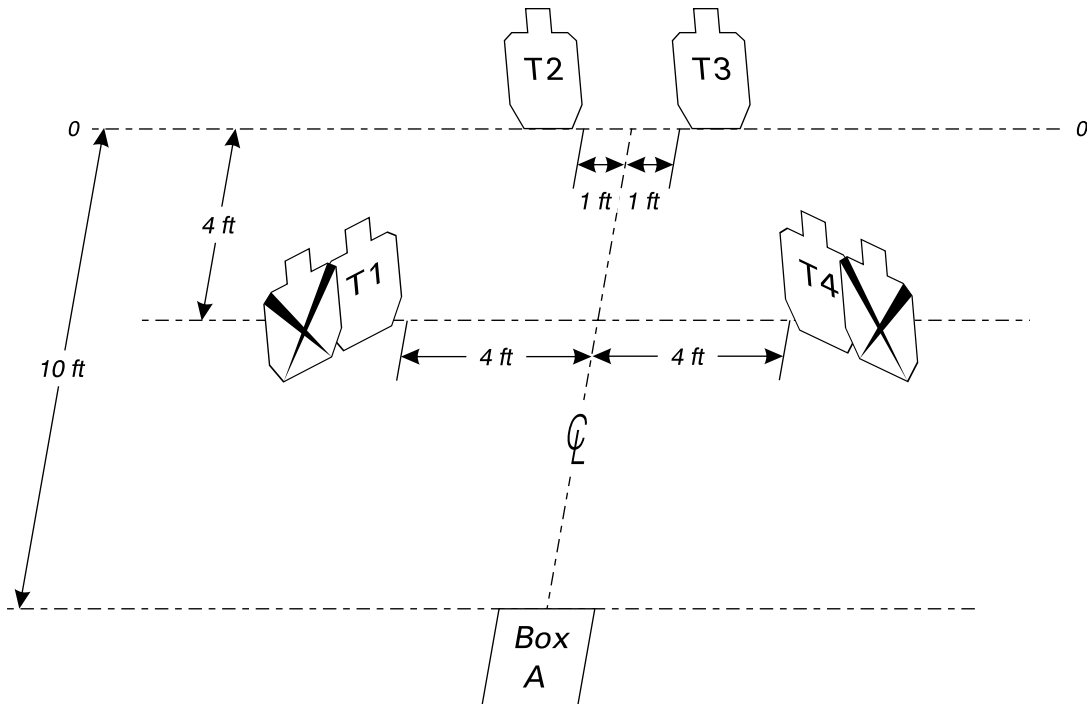
TARGETS: 4 IPSC

SCORED HITS: Best 5/paper

START - STOP: Audible - Last shot

PENALTIES: Per current edition of USPSA Rule Book.

Failure to perform reload is per-shot-fired penalty.



SETUP NOTES: Set targets T1 and T4 to 4 feet high at shoulders and angled at 45 degrees from the center line. Set targets T2 and T3 to 5 feet at shoulders. Scoring lines of no-shoots overlay C-zone scoring lines



of targets. Bottom of no-shoot is even with bottom of target. Box A is 3 feet by 3 feet.
