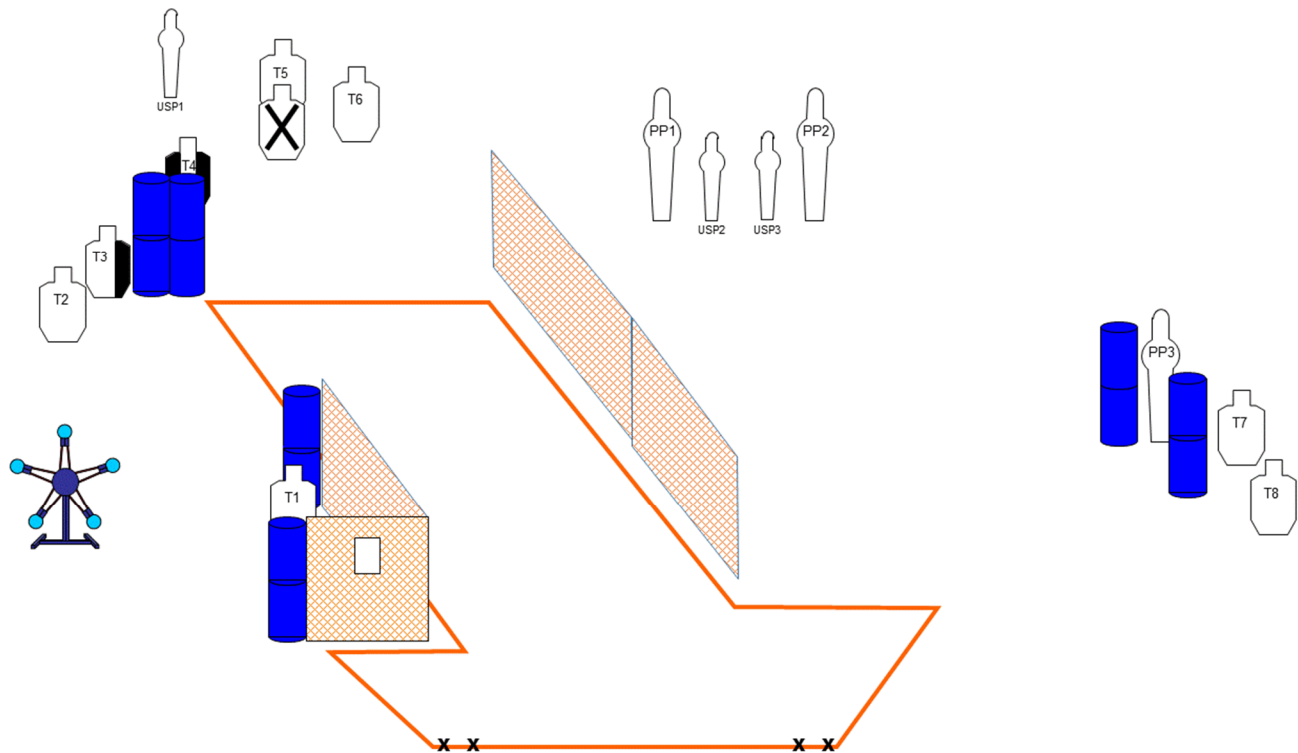
START POSITION: Standing with heels on marks facing downrange. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 or 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal, draw and engage T1-T8 with two (2) rounds each and knock down PP1-PP3, USP1-USP3 and Plates P1-P5.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 27 rounds, 135 points
TARGETS: 8 IPSC, 3 PP, 3 USP, 5 Plates
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
No-shoot hit. -10
Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: Stage 2 – CM 99-11 El Presidente will be setup in the far right corner of the bay. Set T7 & T8 and PP3 so that they do not shoot through to Stage 2.

All steel is at least 8 yards from nearest Fault Line.

Set T1 so that it does not shoot through to T2 or T3. Use barrels/Atto Walls to block T2 & T3 from Port.

Set PP1 so that it may be engaged from forward Fault Line.

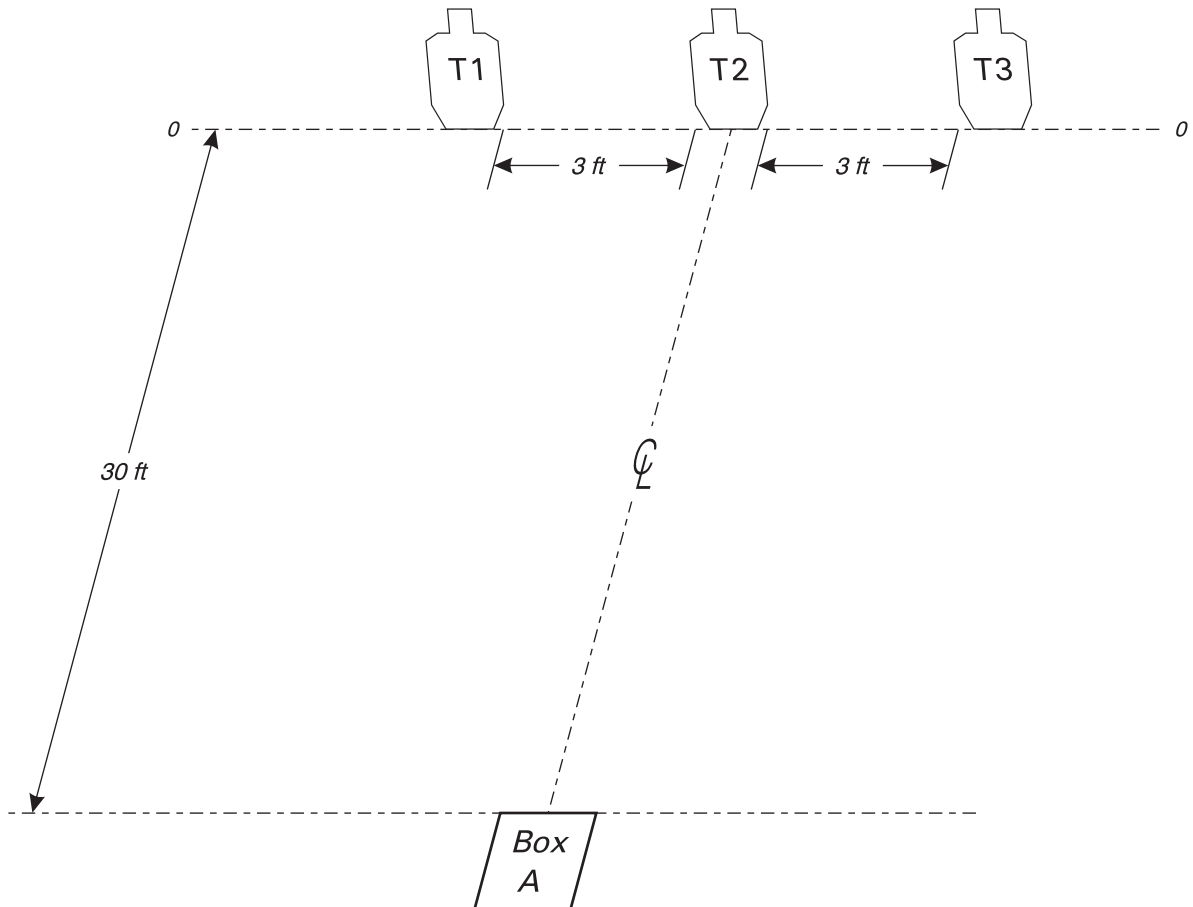
START POSITION: Standing in Box A, back to targets, toes of both feet against rear of fault line of Box A, both wrists above respective shoulders. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 and 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE

Upon start signal, turn then draw and from Box A engage T1-T3 with only two rounds per target, then perform a mandatory reload and from Box A engage T1-T3 with only two rounds per target.

SCORING

SCORING: Virginia Count, 12 rounds, 60 points
TARGETS: 3 IPSC
SCORED HITS: Best 4/paper
START - STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Per current edition USPSA Practical Shooting Handbook.
Failure to perform mandatory reload will result in one procedural penalty per shot fired.



SETUP NOTES: Set targets to 5 feet high at shoulders. Shooting box is 3 feet by 3 feet.

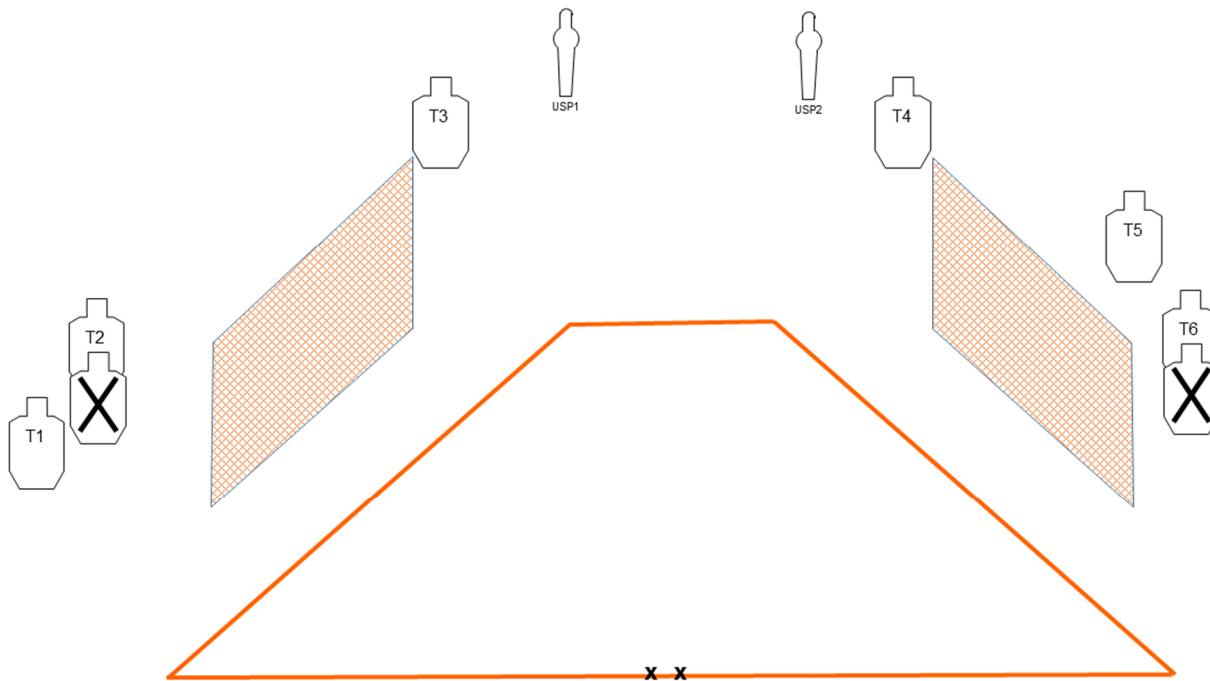
START POSITION: Standing with heels on marks facing downrange. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 or 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal, draw and engage T1-T6 with two (2) rounds each and knock down USP1 & USP2.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 14 rounds, 70 points
TARGETS: 6 IPSC, 2 USP
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
No-shoot hit. -10
Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: Set T5 & T6 so that they do not shoot through to Stage 4.

Stage 4

Shuffle

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Phil McKenzie

START POSITION: Standing with heels on marks facing downrange. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 or 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal, draw and engage T1-T11 with two (2) rounds each.

PP1 activates swinger T5 which remains visible at rest.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 23 rounds, 115 points

TARGETS: 11 IPSC, 1 PP

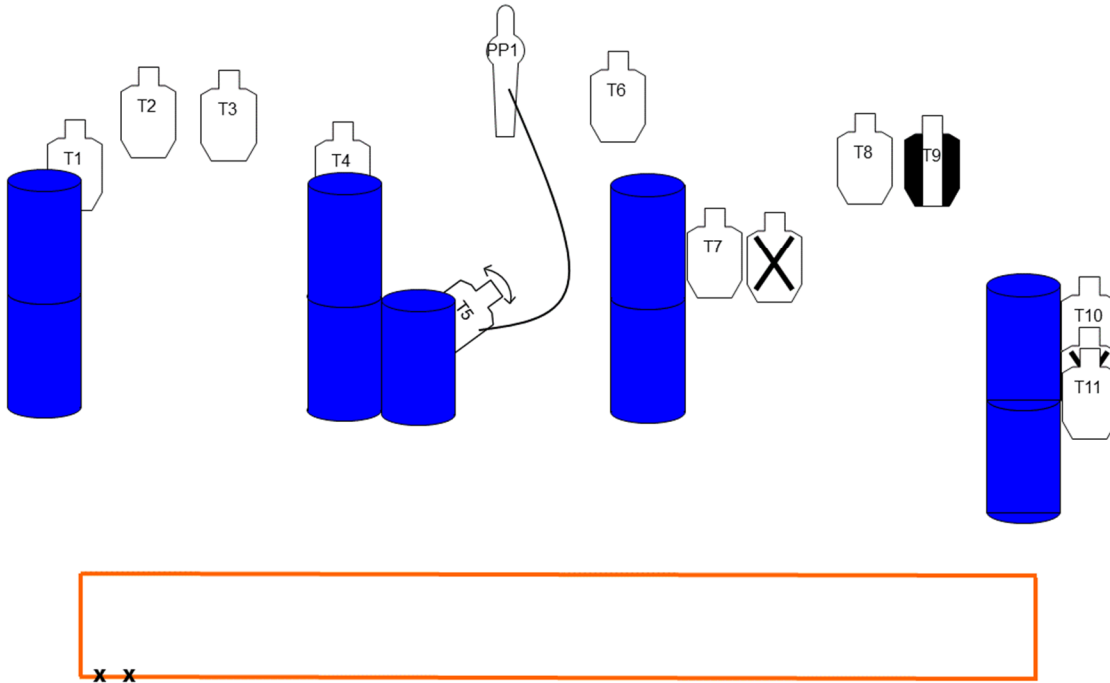
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A

START-STOP: Audible - Last shot

PENALTIES: Procedural. -10

No-shoot hit. -10

Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: T1 & T4 should be hidden from the start position. T10 & T11 are set to force the shooter to go to the right Fault Line.

RO NOTES: Watch for Foot faults.
