#### **RULES:** USPSA Rule Book, Current Edition

COURSE DESIGNER: Nationals Design Team


**START POSITION:** Standing behind barricade, hands on X's. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 and 8.1.2.

### **STAGE PROCEDURE**

Upon start signal, engage all targets as visible All rounds must be fired within the confines of the fault lines.

### SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 6 rounds, 30 points TARGETS: 3 Pepper poppers, 3 US Poppers SCORED HITS: KD = 1A START - STOP: Audible - Last shot PENALTIES: Per current edition of USPSA Rule Book.



**SETUP NOTES:** The popper array is centered on the 2-foot-by-6-foot barricade, 36 feet down range. The poppers are spaced 2 feet on center. Center of X's on barricade are 60 inches above ground, 12 inches apart, and each is 6 inches in from either edge.





**START POSITION:** Standing within the shooting area, with hands relaxed at sides & heels touching marks. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 or 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE On signal engage T1-T6 with two (2) rounds each & knock down PP1, PP2 & PP3. PP1 activates Swinger T3 which remains visible at rest.	SCORINGSCORING:Comstock, 15 rounds, 75 pointsTARGETS:6 Metric & 3 PPSCORED HITS:Best 2 per paper, steel down = 1ASTART-STOP:Audible - Last shotPENALTIES:Per current edition of Rule Book: Procedural10 No-shoot hit10 Miss10







**START POSITION:** Standing anywhere within shooting area with hands relaxed at sides. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rules 8.1.1 or 8.1.2.

<b>STAGE PROCEDURE</b> On signal, engage T1-T9 with two (2) rounds each & knock down PP1 & PP2	SCORINGSCORING:Comstock, 20 rounds, 100 pointsTARGETS:9 Metric & 2 PPSCORED HITS:Best 2 per paper, steel down = 1ASTART-STOP:Audible - Last shot	
	PENALTIES:	Per current edition of Rule Book: Procedural10 No-shoot hit10 Miss10





SETUP NOTES: T3 – T6 are angled to force movement to engage. A shooting line of sight must be created between barrels & targets to engage PP1 & PP2.
