Can You Count

RULES: USPSA Rule Book, Current Edition

COURSE DESIGNER: Mark Ramsey and John Golson

START POSITION: Standing erect in Box A, arms hanging naturally at sides. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 and 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal, from Box A only:

String 1: Engage T1 with five rounds only. Perform a mandatory reload and engage T2 with five rounds only.

String 2: Engage T3 with five rounds only. Perform a mandatory reload and engage T4 with five rounds only.

Targets within a string may be engaged in any order without penalty

SCORING

SCORING: Virginia Count, 20 rounds, 100 points

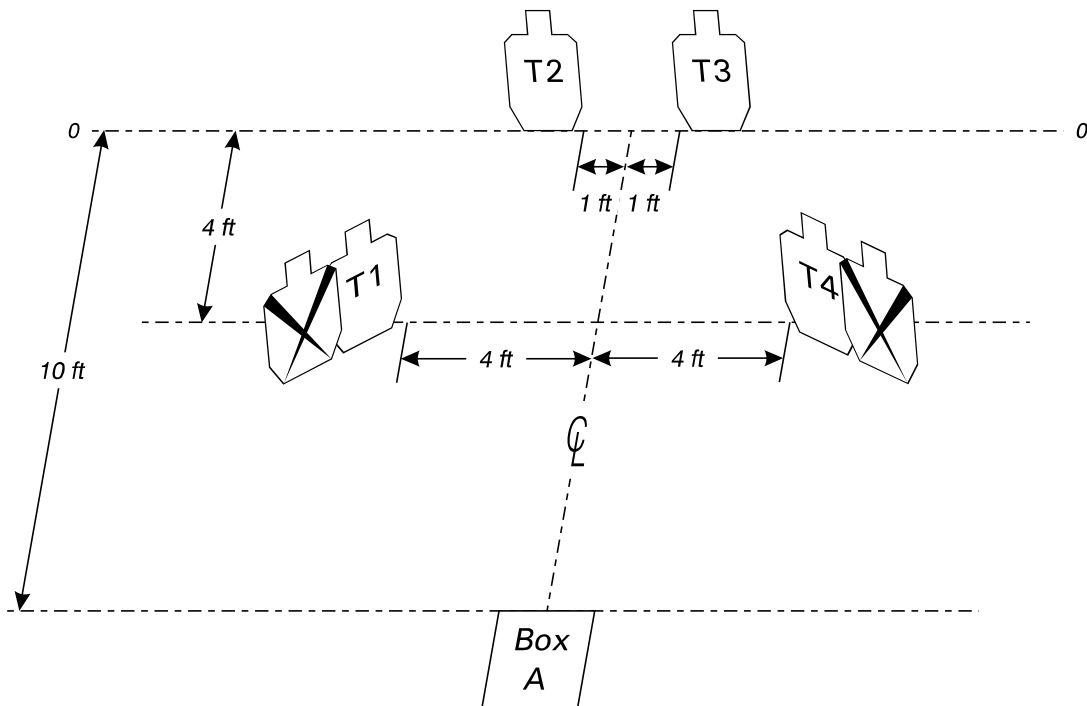
TARGETS: 4 IPSC

SCORED HITS: Best 5/paper

START - STOP: Audible - Last shot

PENALTIES: Per current edition of USPSA Rule Book.

Failure to perform reload is per-shot-fired penalty.



SETUP NOTES: Set targets T1 and T4 to 4 feet high at shoulders and angled at 45 degrees from the center line. Set targets T2 and T3 to 5 feet at shoulders. Scoring lines of no-shoots overlay C-zone scoring lines



of targets. Bottom of no-shoot is even with bottom of target. Box A is 3 feet by 3 feet.

Stage 2

Asymmetric

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition.

COURSE DESIGNER: Phil McKenzie

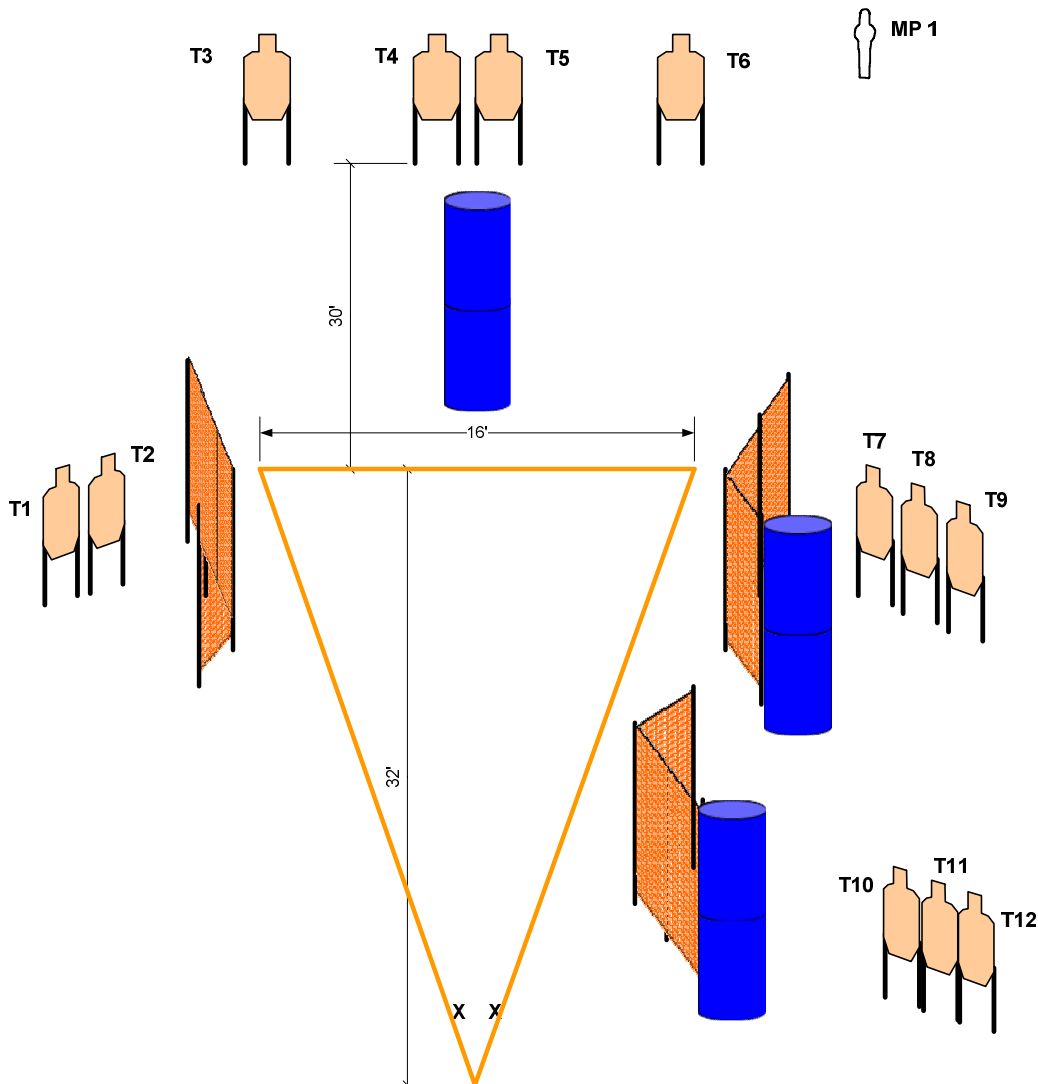
START POSITION: Standing with hands relaxed at sides and standing within the fault lines heels touching marks.
Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 or 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal engage T1-T12 with two (2) rounds each & knock down steel MP1.
All walls extend vertically to infinity.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 25 rounds, 125 points
TARGETS: Metric - 12 paper & 1 MP
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per paper, Steel Down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Per current edition of Rule Book:
Procedural. -10
Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: Maintain fault line 3 feet from walls.
Dimensions on drawing are estimates. Location of targets will be placed for optimal engagement. Assure barrels are partially blocking a clear shot to T4 & T5 from start position. Protect the 180°.

Stage 3

Paper

COURSE DESIGNER: Phil McKenzie

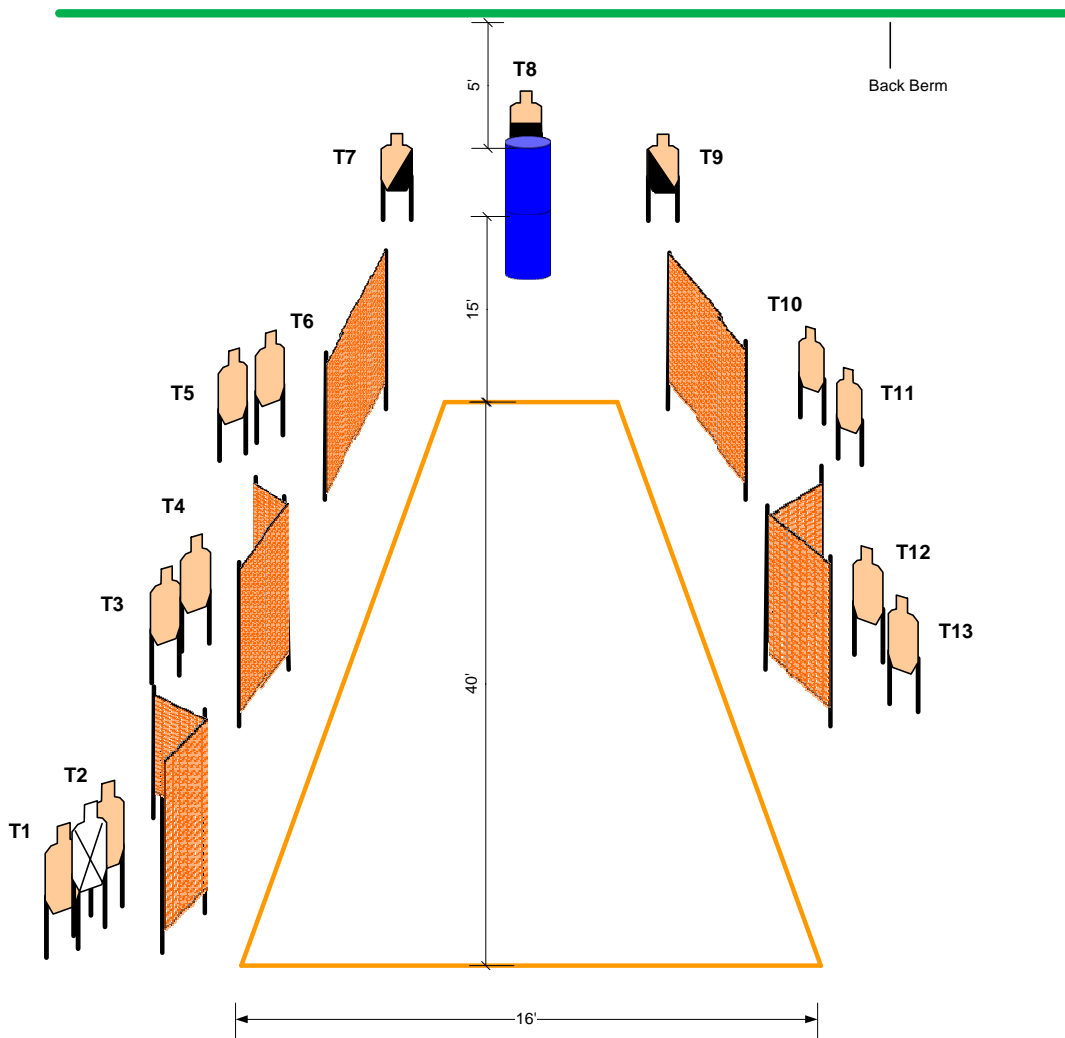
START POSITION: Standing inside the shooting area, hands relaxed at sides with heels touching anywhere on the back fault line. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 or 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal engage T1-T13 with two (2) rounds each.
All walls extend vertically to infinity.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 26 rounds, 130 points
TARGETS: Metric - 13 paper
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per paper
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Per current edition of Rule Book:
Procedural. -10
No-shoot hit. -10
Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: Maintain fault line 3 feet from walls.
Dimensions on drawing are estimates. Location of targets will be placed for optimal engagement. Protect the 180°

Three to Right

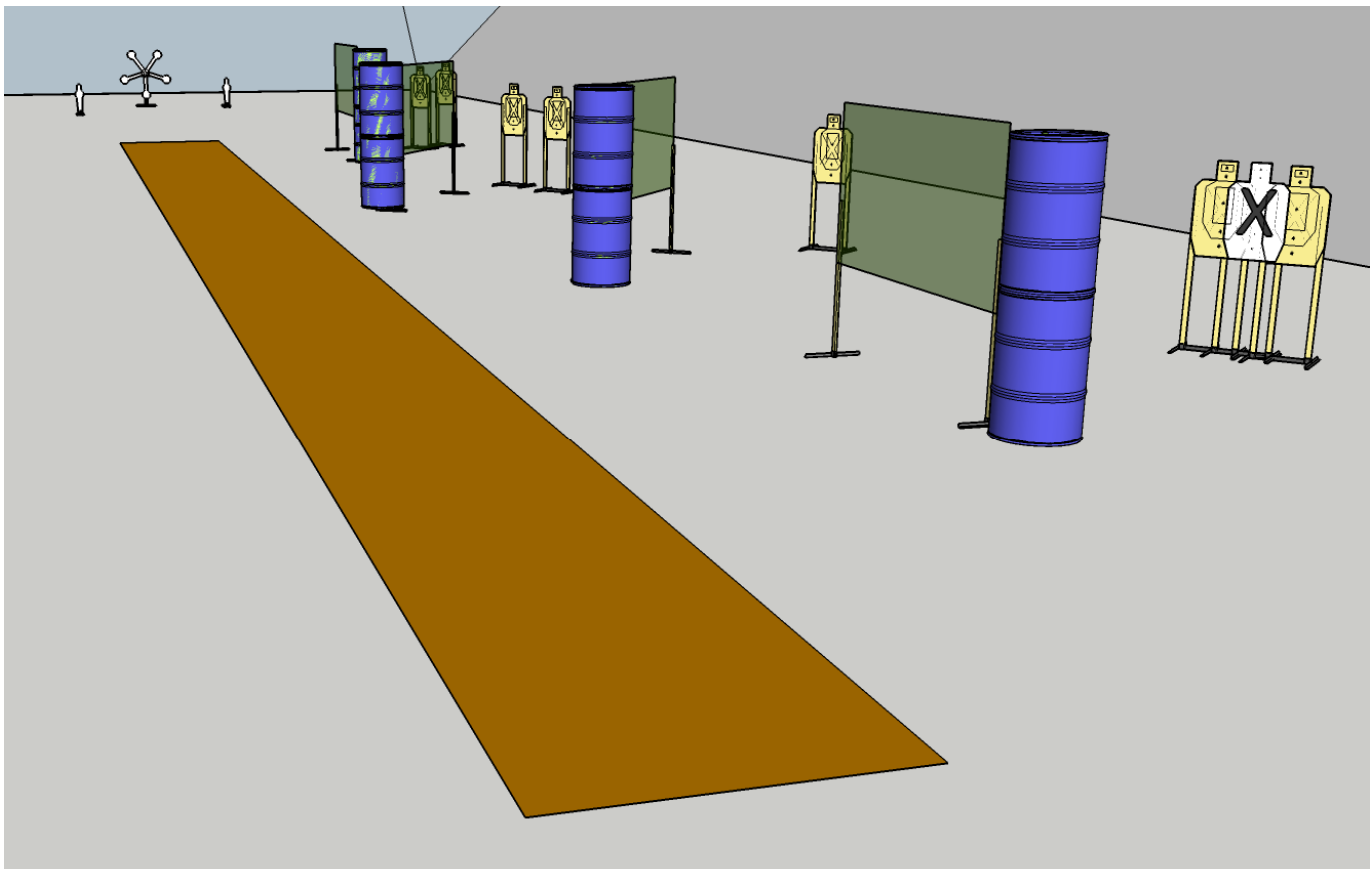
START POSITION: Standing with heels touching marks on rear fault line with hands relaxed at sides.
Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 or 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal engage T1 - T7 with two (2) rounds each & knock down 5 steel plates & MP2.
All walls extend vertically to infinity.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock - 21 rounds, 105 points
TARGETS: Metric - 7 paper, 5 steel plates, 2 MP1
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per paper, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Per current edition of Rule Book:
Procedural. -10
No-shoot hit. -10
Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: Maintain fault line 3 feet from wall. Protect the 180°.
