For That Day

RULES: USPSA Handgun Competition Rules, current edition. Course Designer: Nationals Design Team

STAGE PROCEDURE

String 1: On the audible start signal from within shooting area, engage T1 with only 6 rounds freestyle, perform a mandatory reload, and engage T3 with only 6 rounds, *strong* hand only.

String 2: On the audible start signal from within shooting area, engage T2 with only 3 rounds freestyle, perform a mandatory reload, and engage T2 with only 3 rounds, *weak* hand only.

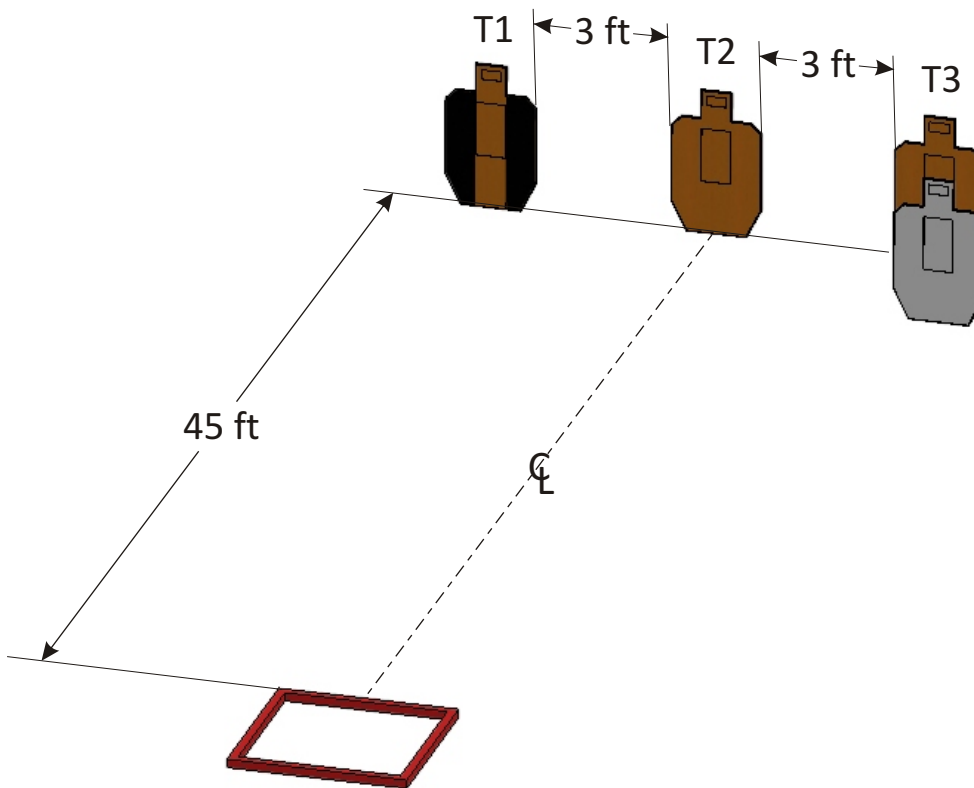
Scoring: Virginia, 18 rounds, 90 points

Targets: 3 USPSA Targets

Scored Hits: Best 6/paper

Start - Stop: Audible - Last Shot

Penalties: Per current edition of USPSA Handgun Competition Rules.



SETUP NOTES: Set targets 5 feet to top. Box is 3 feet by 3 feet. Left edge of no-shoot is lined up with left edge of A-zone, top of no-shoot (not the scoring zone line) is lined up with bottom of target lettering. Target T1 hardcover is set to both edges of A-zone.

For That Day

For That Day is a 18 round, 90-point, Virginia Count Standard Exercise. There are 3 IPSC targets. The best 6 hits per paper will score.

The handgun start position is standing inside shooting area, wrists above respective shoulders with handgun loaded and holstered.

The PCC start position is standing inside shooting area, holding loaded PCC, stock on belt, and muzzle pointing downrange.

String 1: On the audible start signal from within shooting area, engage T1 with only 6 rounds freestyle, perform a mandatory reload, and engage T3 with only 6 rounds, *strong* hand only.

String 2: On the audible start signal from within shooting area, engage T2 with only 3 rounds freestyle, perform a mandatory reload, and engage T2 with only 3 rounds, *weak* hand only.



Stage 2

J-Frame

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Bretton Rebol

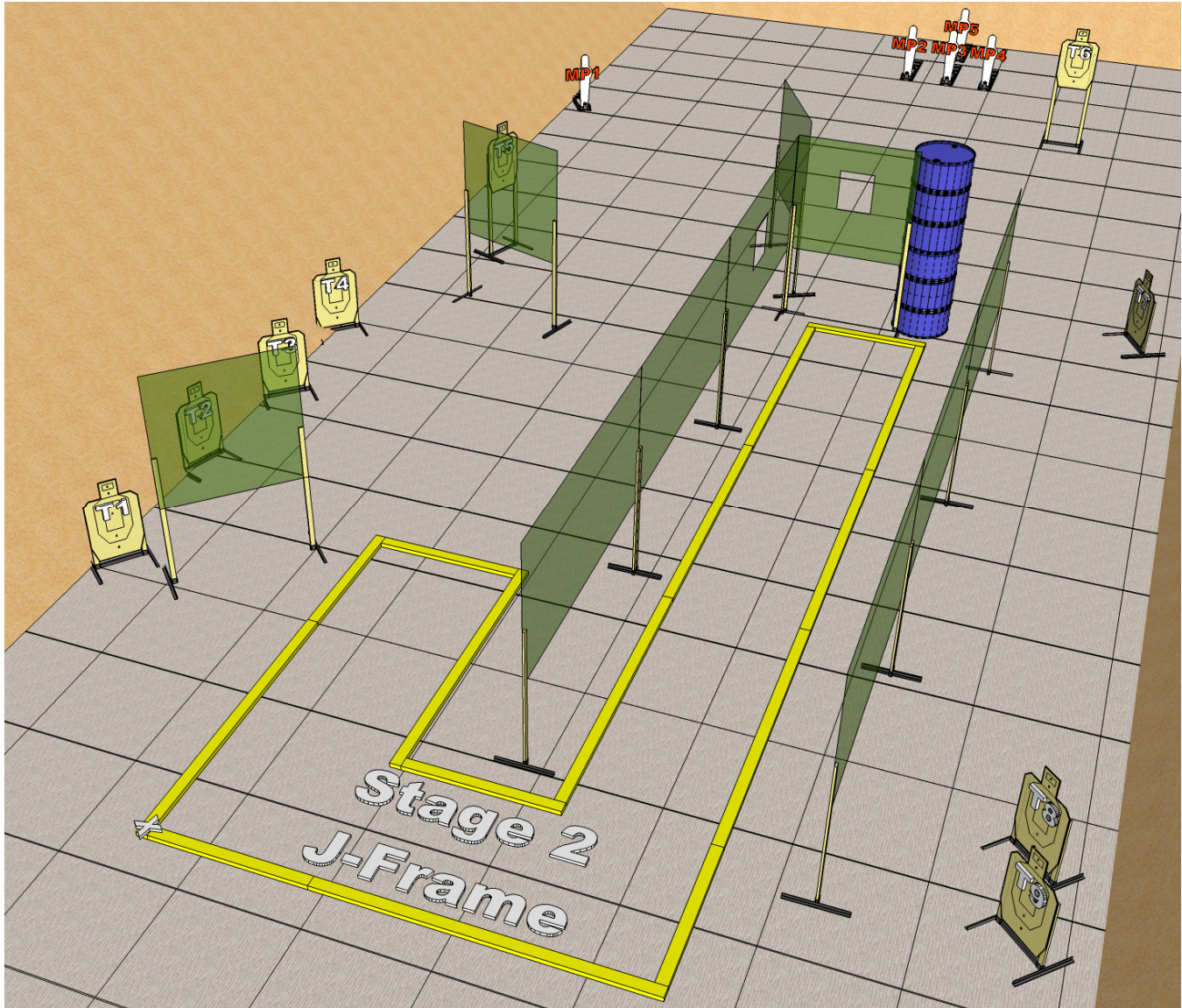
START POSITION: Standing with toes touching Fault Line on opposite sides of mark. Handgun is loaded and holstered. PCC is loaded and held in both hands, with butt on belt and muzzle pointed safely downrange.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On start signal, engage T1-T9 with two (2) rounds each and knock down MP1-MP5 from within the shooting area.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 23 rounds, 115 points
TARGETS: 9 USPSA, 5 Mini-Poppers
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per USPSA, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: Set MP1 at least 23' from Fault Line at left port. MP2-5 are at least 23' from forward port. 4' wall at T1 blocks T2-T4 from left back corner. 4' wall at T5 blocks T5 & MP1 from left side of shooting area. 4' wall between ports blocks MP2-5 from left side of shooting area and MP1 from front port. Barrels are used to prevent shooting MP2-5 from right side of 4' wall.

RO NOTES: Watch for Foot Faults and 180 breaks going around the wall. Watch the retreat from the left side of the shooting area. Check ports for full diameter hits before scoring.

Stage 3

My Space Invaders

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Bretton Rebol

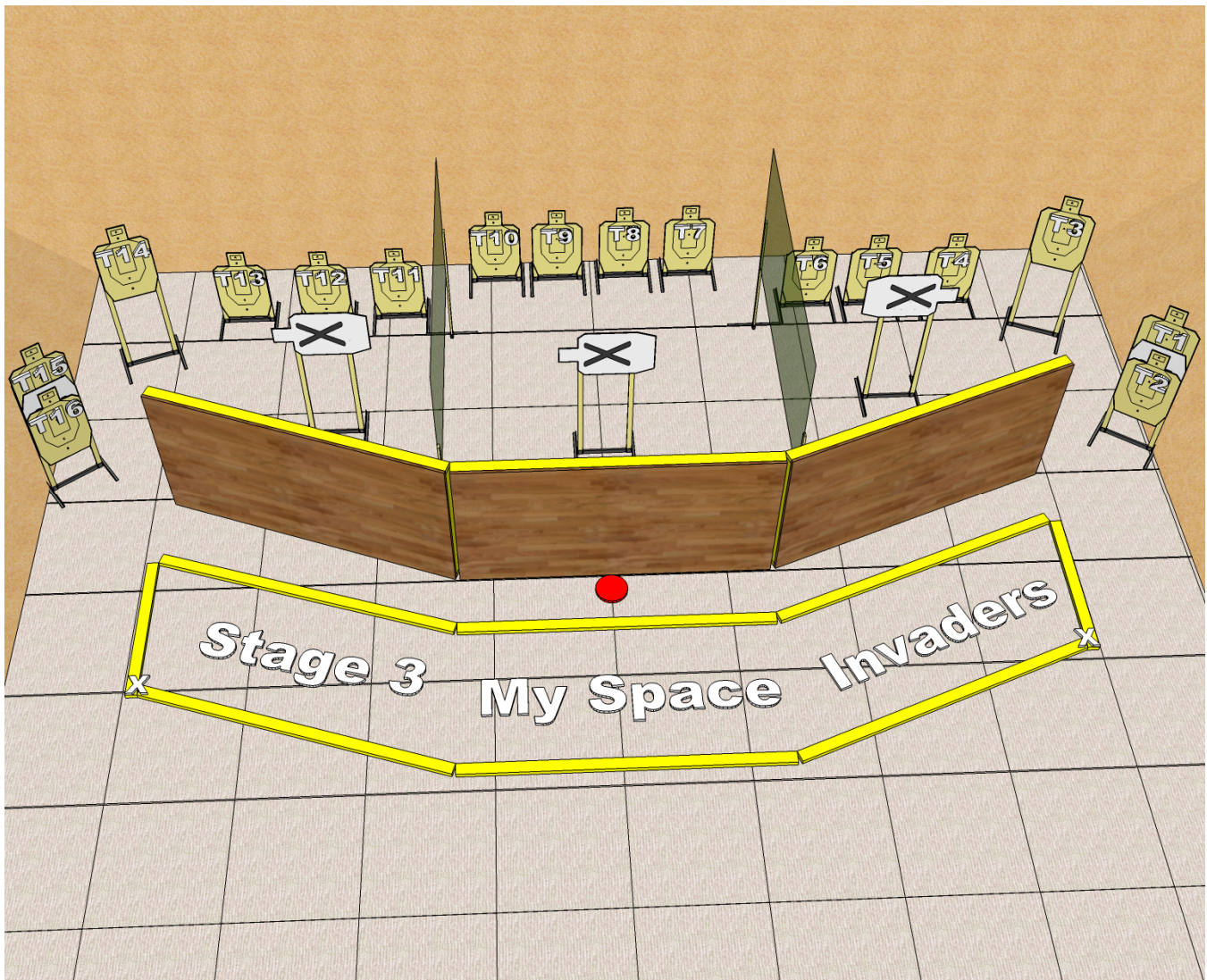
START POSITION: Standing in either corner with heels touching the fault line on opposite sides of the mark. Handgun is loaded and holstered.
PCC is loaded and held in both hands, with butt on belt and muzzle pointed at cone.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On start signal, engage T1-T16 with two (2) rounds each from within the shooting area.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 32 rounds, 160 points
TARGETS: 16 USPSA
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per USPSA
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
No-shoot hit. -10
Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: Place T7-T10 against back berm. Leave enough space between end of walls and T7/T10 to pass through. Place T6 & T11 so that they cannot be seen from the center. Use solid 4'x8' walls and place at end of 8' snow fence walls. Angle the two end solid walls back ~3'. Run Fault Line ~18" from solid walls.

RO NOTES: Watch for Foot Faults.

Stage 4

Zombie Prom

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Bretton Rebol

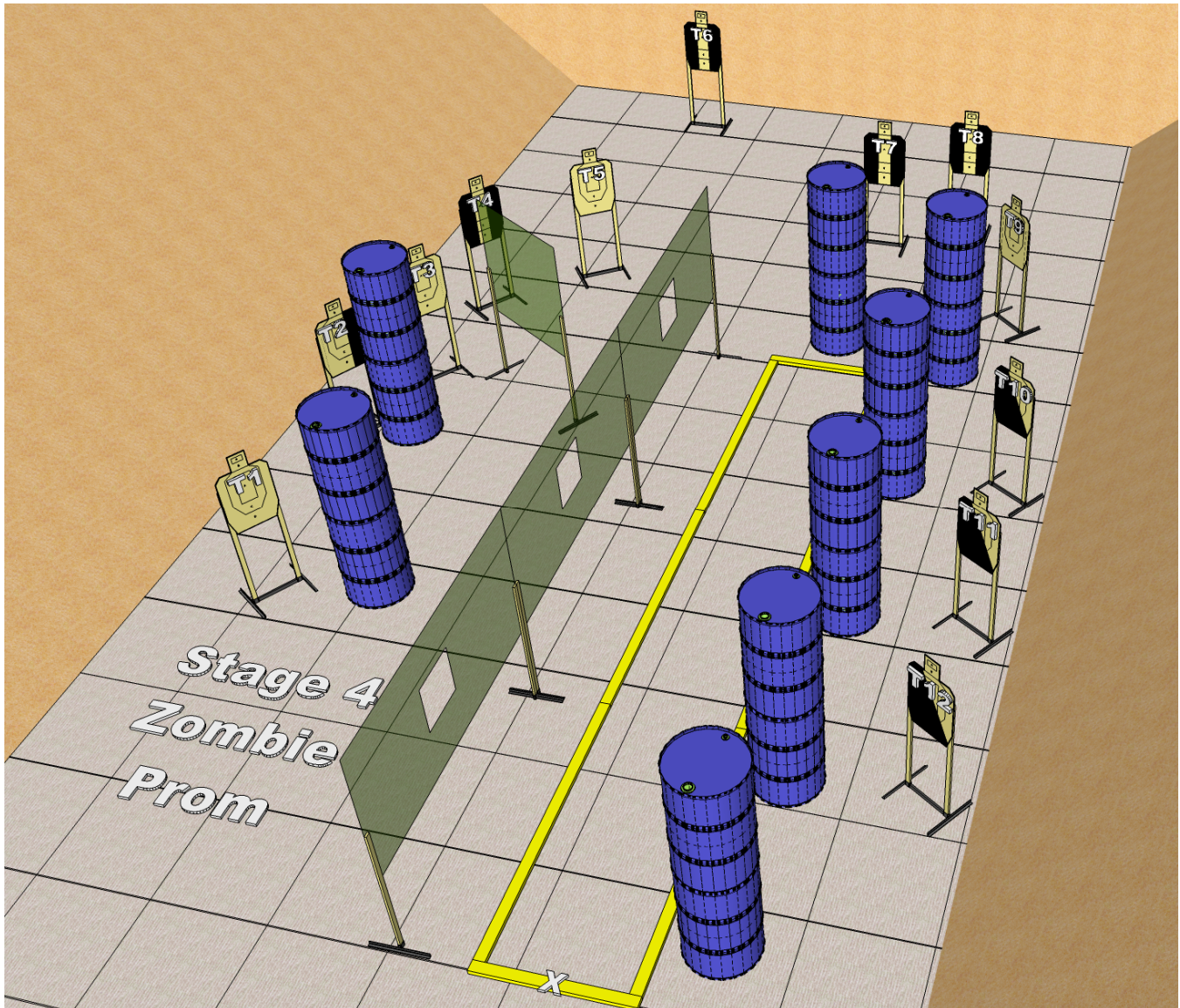
START POSITION: Standing outside of the shooting area with feet touching the fault line on opposite sides of the mark.
Handgun is loaded and holstered. PCC is loaded and held in both hands, with butt on belt and muzzle pointed safely downrange.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On start signal, engage T1-T12 with two (2) rounds each from within the shooting area.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 24 rounds, 120 points
TARGETS: 12 USPSA
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per USPSA
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: Use the barrels and walls as shown to hide targets past the 180.

RO NOTES: Watch for foot faults and 180.
Check ports for full diameter hits before scoring.

Stage 5

Star Struck

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Bretton Rebol

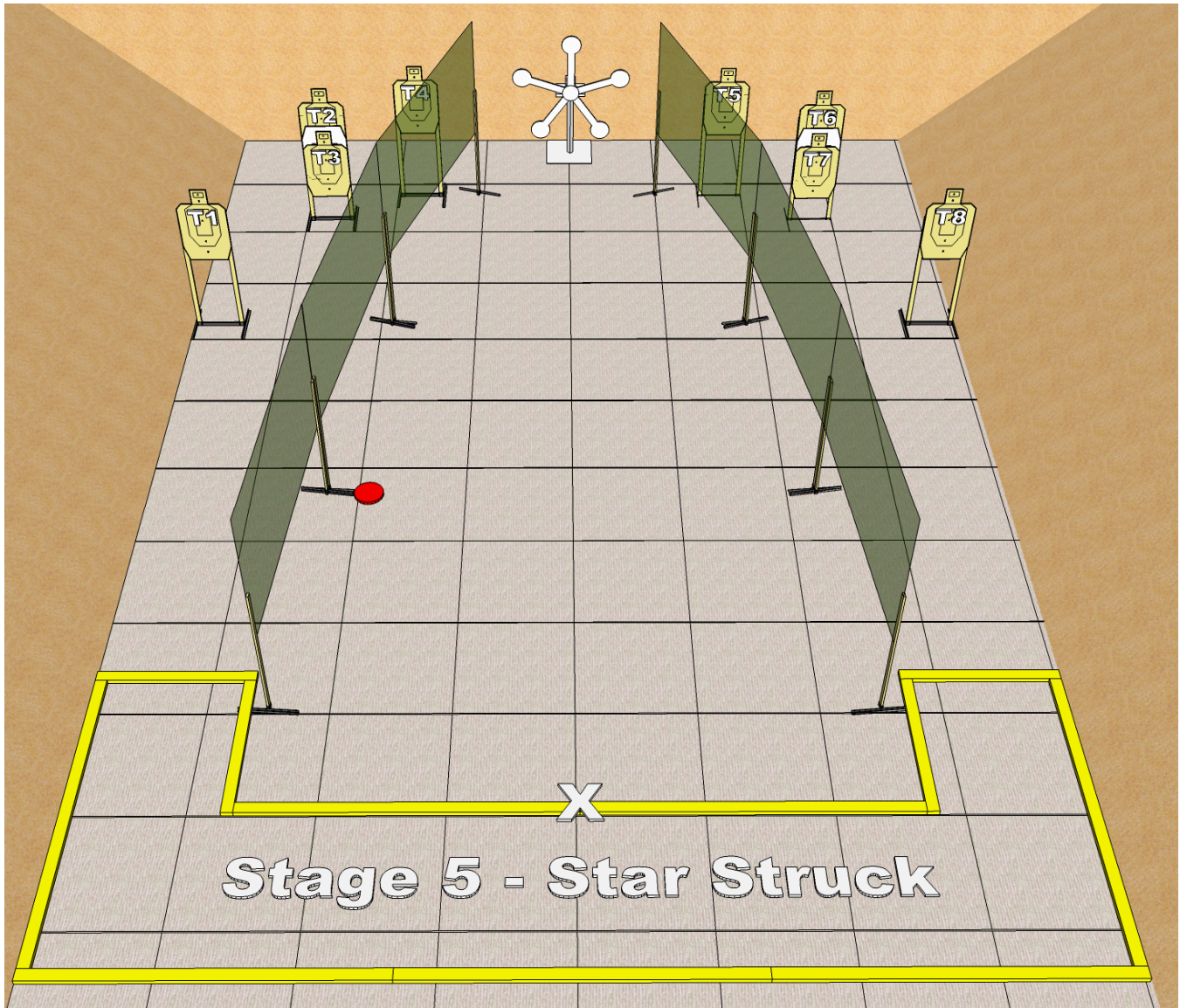
START POSITION: Standing with feet touching fault line on opposite sides of the mark. Handgun is loaded and holstered. PCC is loaded and held in both hands, with butt on belt and muzzle pointed at cone.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On start signal, engage T1-T8 with two (2) rounds each and knock down plates P1-P5.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 21 rounds, 105 points
TARGETS: 8 USPSA, 5 Plates
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per USPSA, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
No-shoot hit. -10
Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: Curve walls as shown and keep them 2' ~ 3' from Texas Star. Set targets to eliminate shoot throughs. Fault lines extend past the wall by 1' as shown.

RO NOTES: Watch for Foot Faults and 180.

Stage 6

Right Down the Middle

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Bretton Rebol

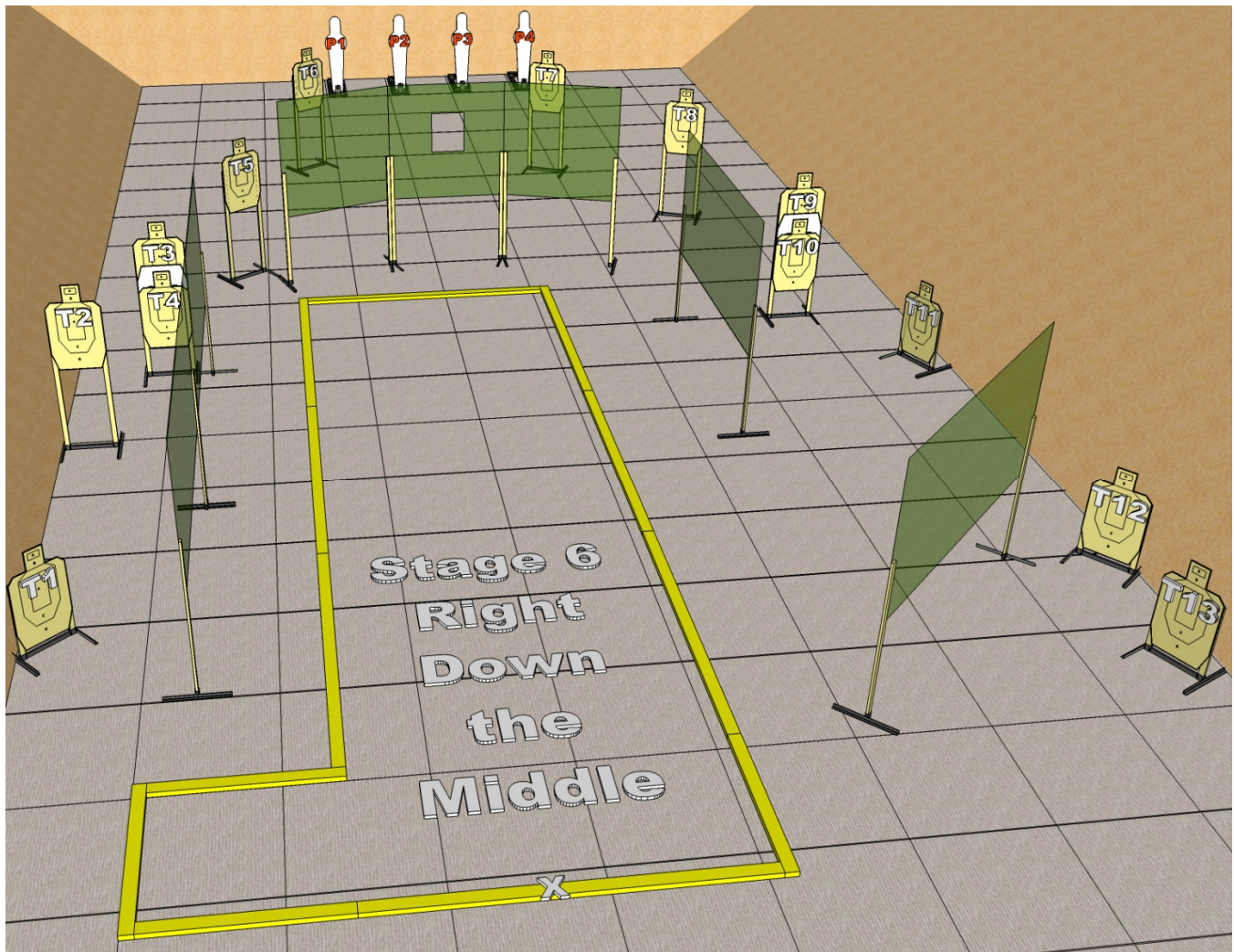
START POSITION: Standing with both feet touching fault line on opposite sides of the mark. Handgun is unloaded and holstered. PCC is unloaded and held in both hands, with butt on belt and muzzle pointed safely downrange.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On start signal, engage T1-T13 with two (2) rounds each and knock down P1-P4 from within the shooting area.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 30 rounds, 150 points
TARGETS: 13 USPSA, 4 USPSA Poppers
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per USPSA, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
No-shoot hit. -10
Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: Poppers are set against the read berm. Forward fault line is at least 23' from the poppers. Set T6 & T7i so that they may only be engaged through the port and to force shooter as far as possible side to side across the forward fault line. Set other targets as shown and prevent 180 traps.

RO NOTES: Watch for Foot Faults and 180. Check the port for full diameter hits prior to scoring.
