RULES: USPSA Handgun Competition Rules, current edition COURSE DESIGNER: Jeff Cooper


START POSITION: Standing in Box A, back to targets, toes of both feet against rear of fault line of Box A, both wrists above respective shoulders. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 and 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE

Upon start signal, turn then draw and from Box A engage T1-T3 with only two rounds per target, then perform a mandatory reload and from Box A engage T1-T3 with only two rounds per target.

SCORING

SCORING: Virginia Count, 12 rounds, 60 points TARGETS: 3 Metric SCORED HITS: Best 4/paper START - STOP: Audible - Last shot PENALTIES: Per current edition USPSA Handgun Competition Rules Failure to perform mandatory reload will result in one procedural penalty per shot fired.



SETUP NOTES: Set targets to 5 feet high at shoulders. Shooting box is 3 feet by 3 feet.

Written Stage Briefing

El Presidente is a 12-round, 60-point Virginia Count Classifier Course. There are three metric targets. The best four hits per target will score. The start signal is audible

Start Position: Standing in Box A, back to targets, toes of both feet against rear of fault line of Box A, both wrists above respective shoulders. Your gun will be loaded and holstered.

PCC start position is standing in Box A, facing downrange, stock on belt, muzzle downrange, loaded carbine held in both hands with safety on.


On the start signal, from Box A only, turn then draw and engage T1-T3 with only two rounds per target, make a mandatory reload, then engage T1-T3 with only two rounds per target.

PCC: No turn



Lean + Long

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition COURSE DESIGNER: Bretton Rebol



SETUP NOTES: Align the Mini Poppers so that they have to be taken one at a time. Set walls to force engagement of the mini poppers from the 'L' in Lean. Set barrel between T6 & T7 to force shooter to both ends of the forward Fault Line. 4' wall blocks T9 & 10 from forward Fault Line. Set barrel across from T12 to block view of T11 (can't engage both at the same time) and the 180.


Up To My Evil Ways

PENALTIES: Procedural. -10

No-shoot hit. -10

START POSITION: Standing with heels on start stick. Handgun is loaded and holstered. PCC is loaded and held in both hands, with butt on belt and muzzle pointed safely downrange.	
STAGE PROCEDURE On start signal, engage T1-T10 with two (2) rounds each and knock down Plates P1-P5 from within the shooting area.	SCORING SCORING: Comstock, 25 rounds, 125 points TARGETS: 10 USPSA, 5 Plates SCORED HITS: Best 2 per USPSA, steel down = 1A START-STOP: Audible - Last shot




SETUP NOTES: Barrels set on 180 across from T8-T10. Set T5 behind the barrels to force shooter to right hand corner. Make sure walls only allow engagement of the Texas Star from the left side and T3 from the front left location. Barrels block the left two (2) plates on the Texas Star.

RO NOTES: Watch for Foot Faults.

Playing With New Toys

START POSITION: Standing with toes on start stick. Handgun is loaded and holstered. PCC is loaded and held in both hands, with butt on belt and muzzle pointed safely downrange.		
STAGE PROCEDURE On start signal, engage T1-T10 with two (2) rounds each and	SCORING SCORING: Comstock, 22 rounds, 110 points	
knock down Poppers P1 & P2 from within the shooting area. Popper P1 activates Bobber Target T4 and Popper P2	TARGETS: 10 USPSA, 2 Poppers SCORED HITS: Best 2 per USPSA, steel down = 1A START-STOP: Audible - Last shot	
activates Bobber Target T5. Both Bobbers remain visible at rest.	PENALTIES: Procedural10 No-shoot hit10 Miss10	



SETUP NOTES: Use the grid as a guideline. Fault Lines are 8' or 4' as shown. Forward Fault Line should be relatively parallel with the back berm and rear fault line (with start stick). Right and Left fault lines are square with the side berms as well. Poppers as close to back berm as possible. Forward Fault Line is ~8 $\frac{1}{2}$ yards from poppers.


RO NOTES: Watch the 180° on the handgun draw and for Foot Faults.

Blazing In Munchkin Land

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition COURSE DESIGNER: Bretton Rebol

START POSITION: Standing facing downrange with heels on start stick. Handgun is loaded and holstered. PCC is is loaded and held in both hands, shouldered with muzzle pointed safely downrange.

STAGE PROCEDURE	SCORING
On start signal, engage T1-T29 with one (1) round each.	SCORING: Virginia count, 29 rounds, 145 points
	TARGETS: 29 Mini USPSA
	SCORED HITS: Best 1 per Mini USPSA
	START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
	PENALTIES: Procedural10
	Extra shot10
	Extra hit10
	Miss10



SETUP NOTES: Stagger the walls as shown (1-yard offset). Do NOT overlap the targets.

RO NOTES: Watch the 180° and for extra shots.

Twin Peaks


RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition COURSE DESIGNER: Bretton Rebol

START POSITION: Standing directly behind the center barrels with both hands touching the barrel. Handgun is loaded and holstered. PCC is loaded and held in both hands, with butt on belt and muzzle pointed safely downrange touching the barrel.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On start signal, engage T1-T8 with two (2) rounds each and knock down mini-poppers MP1-MP4 from within the shooting area.

SCORING SCORING: Comstock, 20 rounds, 100 points TARGETS: 8 USPSA, 4 Mini-Poppers SCORED HITS: Best 2 per USPSA, steel down = 1A START-STOP: Audible - Last shot PENALTIES: Procedural. -10 Miss. -10




SETUP NOTES: Set barrels to force shooter to engage the mini poppers only from the peaks. T1, T2, T7 & T8 are set on short sticks.

RO NOTES: Watch the 180° and for foot faults.

Down Right Evil

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition COURSE DESIGNER: Bretton Rebol

START POSITION: Standing facing downrange in box. Handgun is loaded and holstered. PCC is loaded and held in both hands, with butt on belt and muzzle pointed safely downrange.		
STAGE PROCEDURE On start signal, engage T1-T4 with two (2) rounds each. Make a mandatory reload and re-engage T1-T4 with two (2) rounds each Weak hand (shoulder) only from within the box. No stacking of shots.	SCORING SCORING: Comstock, 16 rounds, 80 points TARGETS: 4 USPSA SCORED HITS: Best 4 per USPSA START-STOP: Audible - Last shot PENALTIES: Procedural10 No-shoot hit10	



SETUP NOTES: Get Bretton to set the targets. Remember to staple so that targets can be replaced easily, and witness mark the targets.
