Crackerjack

RULES: USPSA Handgun Competition Rules, current edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Russell Cluver

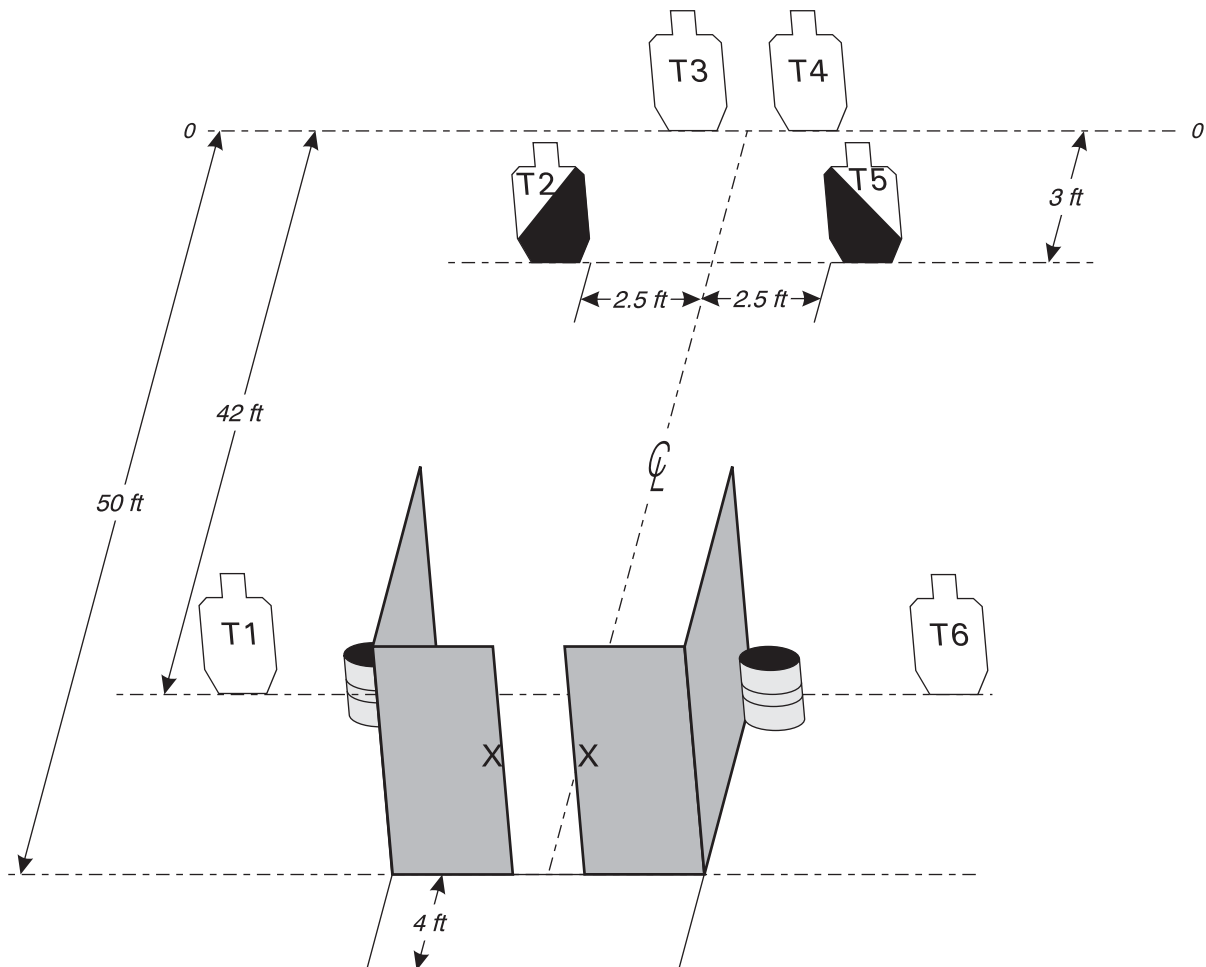
START POSITION: Standing centered in the shooting area, hands on the marks. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 and 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal, draw and engage targets while remaining in the shooting area.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 12 rounds, 60 points
TARGETS: 6 Metric
SCORED HITS: Best 2/paper
START - STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Per current edition of USPSA Handgun Competition Rules



SETUP NOTES: T2, T3, T4, and T5 are 5 feet high at shoulders. T1 and T6 are 4 feet high at shoulders. T3 and T4 are 12 inches apart edge to edge (6 inches left and right of centerline). T1 and T6 are 66 inches left and right of the barricade walls. The side walls of the barricade are 8 feet by



8 feet. The front walls are 4 feet by 8 feet with a 19-inch wide gap between them. Place the barrels so they are against the walls with the back of the barrels even with the back edge of the walls. X marks for hand positions are 4 feet up on the wall at the edge of the port. Barrels are plastic blue water barrels.

Written Stage Briefing

Crackerjack is a 12 round, 60-point Comstock Classifier course. There are 6 Metric targets. The best two hits per target will score. The start signal is audible.

The start position will be centered within the fault lines. Your hands will be on the marks on the wall. Your gun will be loaded and holstered. PCC start position is standing centered behind the wall, facing downrange, stock on belt, muzzle touching one of the marks, loaded carbine held in both hands with safety on.

On the start signal, engage targets while remaining in shooting area.



Stage 2

Long & Short of It

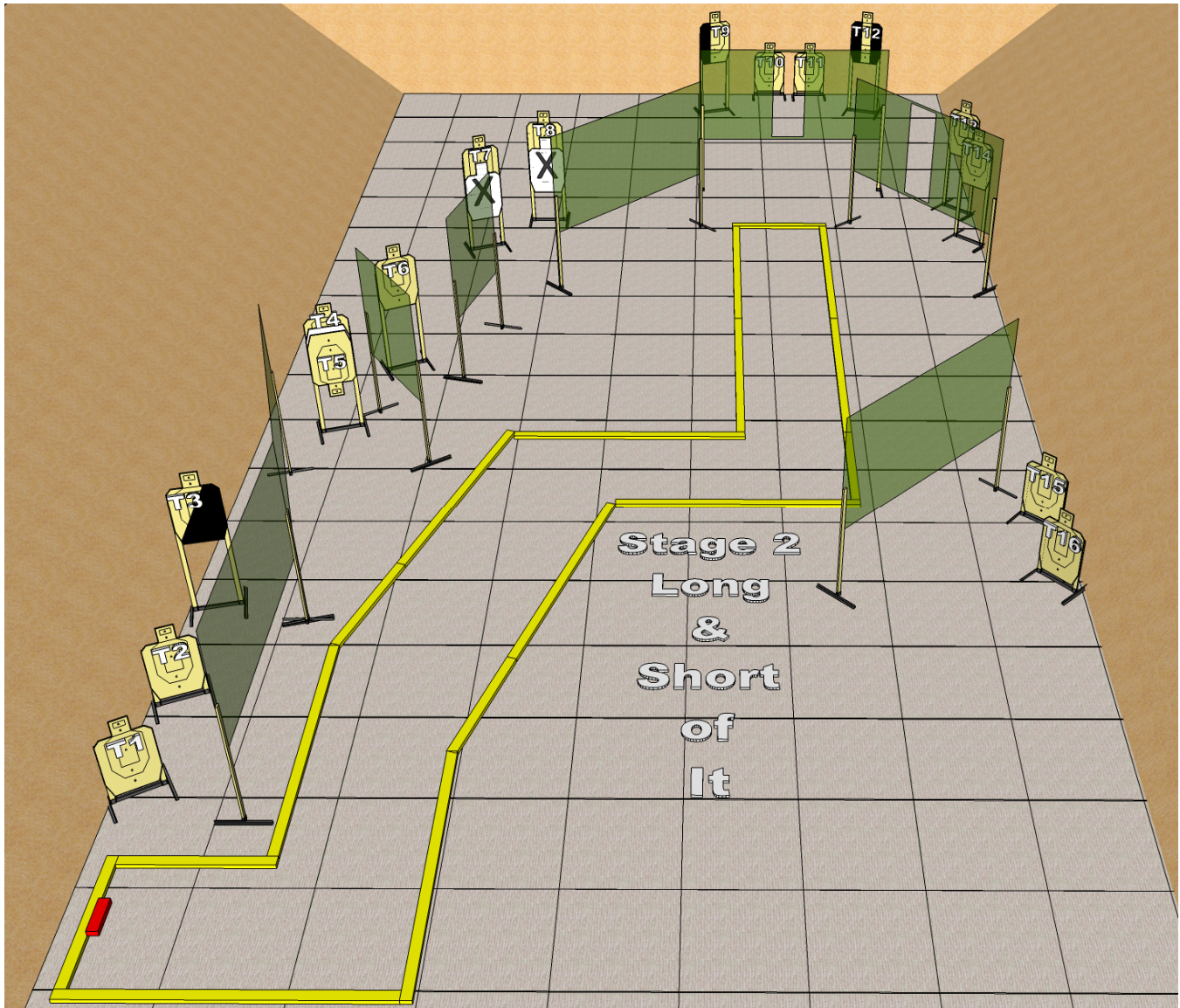
START POSITION: Feet touching the Start Stick. Handgun is loaded and holstered with wrists below belt.
PCC is loaded and held in both hands, shouldered with muzzle pointed safely downrange.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On start signal, engage T1-T16 with two (2) rounds each.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 32 rounds, 160 points
TARGETS: 16 USPSA
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per USPSA
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
No-shoot hit. -10
Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: Use the grid (3') as a guide.

RO NOTES: None

Stage 3

Theory

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** DSS

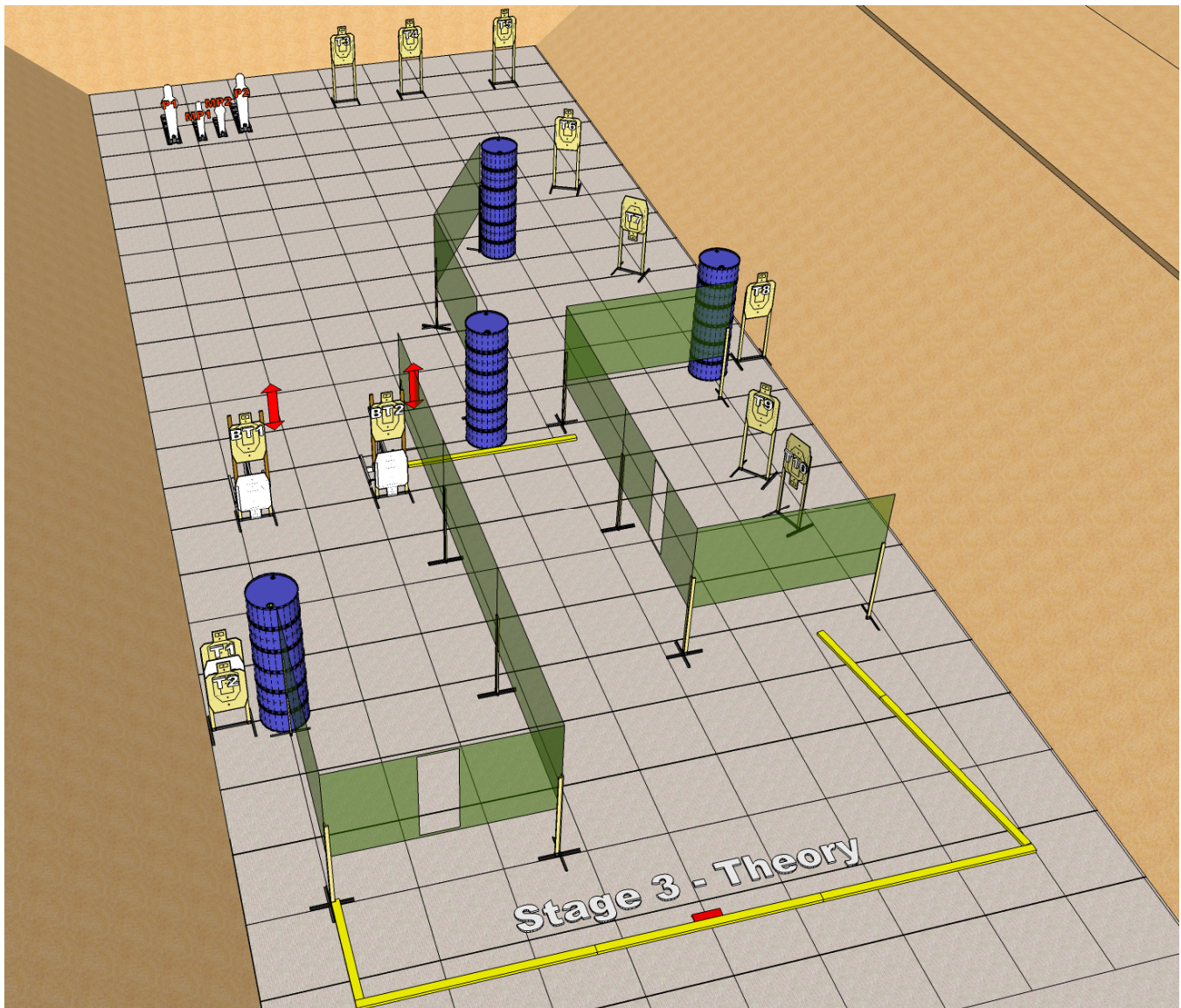
START POSITION: Feet touching the Start Stick. Handgun is loaded and holstered with wrists below belt.
PCC is loaded and held in both hands, with butt on belt and muzzle pointed at the center barrels.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On start signal, engage T1-T10 & BT1-BT2 with two (2) rounds each and knock down P1-P2 & MP1-MP2.
P1 activates Bobber Target BT1 and P2 activates Bobber Target BT2.
BT1 & BT2 remain visible at rest and must be activated before engaging.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 28 rounds, 140 points
TARGETS: 12 USPSA, 2 Poppers, 2 Mini-Poppers
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per USPSA, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
No-shoot hit. -10
Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: Use the grid (3' x 3'). Ensure there is no Shoot Through from T9 to T8. Watch the 180 when setting T10.

RO NOTES: Check that the BT1 & BT2 are properly reset prior to starting shooter.

Stage 4

Easier With Barrels?

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Bretton Rebol

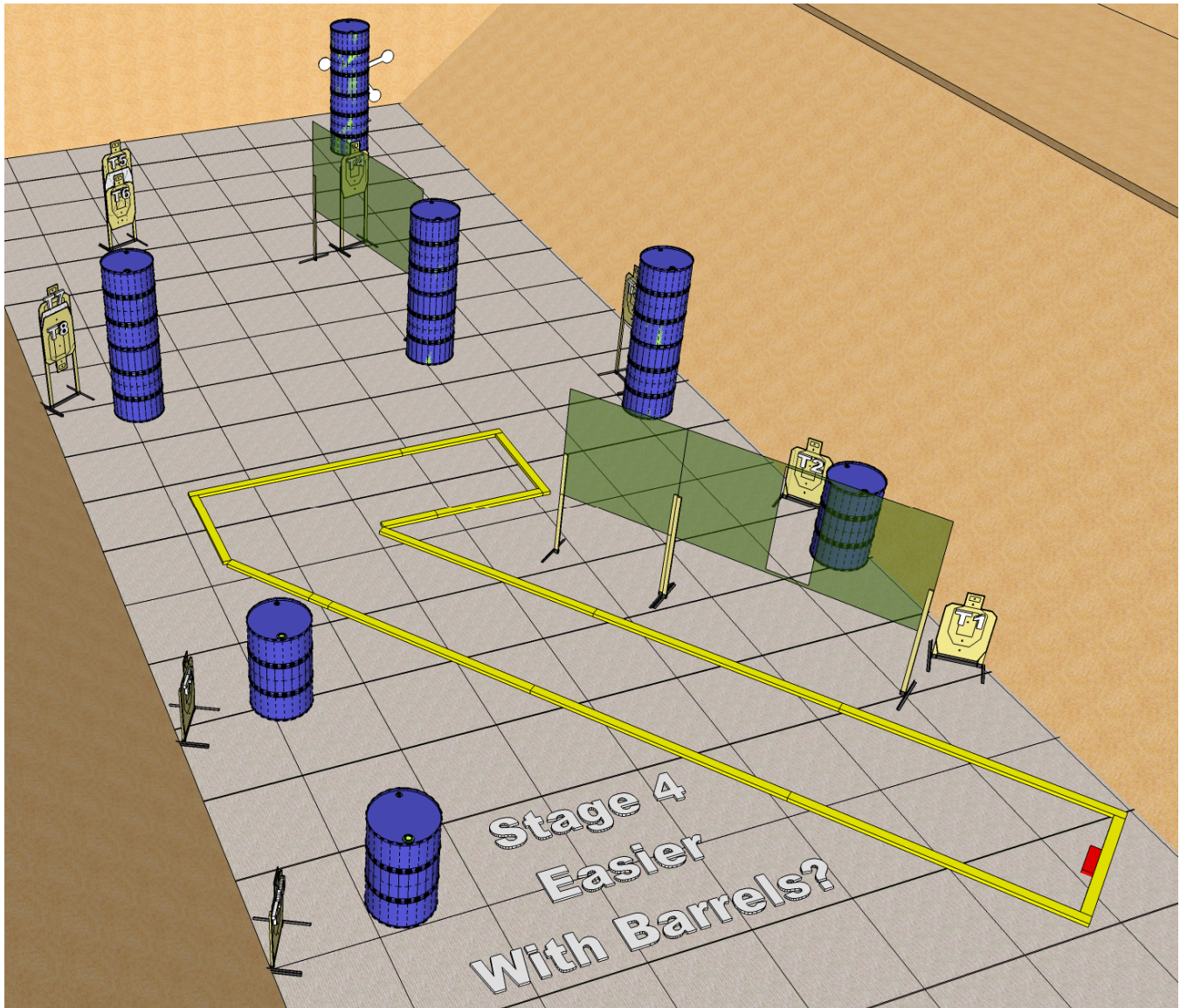
START POSITION: Standing with heels on Start Stick. Handgun is loaded and holstered with wrists below belt.
PCC is loaded and held in both hands, with butt on belt and muzzle pointed safely downrange.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On start signal, engage T1-T10 with two (2) rounds each and knock down Plates P1-P5.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 25 rounds, 125 points
TARGETS: 10 USPSA, 5 Plates
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per USPSA, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
No-shoot hit. -10
Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: Ensure T4 can only be engaged from the start position. T2 is set to be engaged only through the port. Set barrels to block the left side of the Texas Star from the right front shooting area. Barrels blocking T3 from start position also block the Texas Star.

RO NOTES: None

Stage 5

Giants In Munchkin Land

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Bretton Rebol

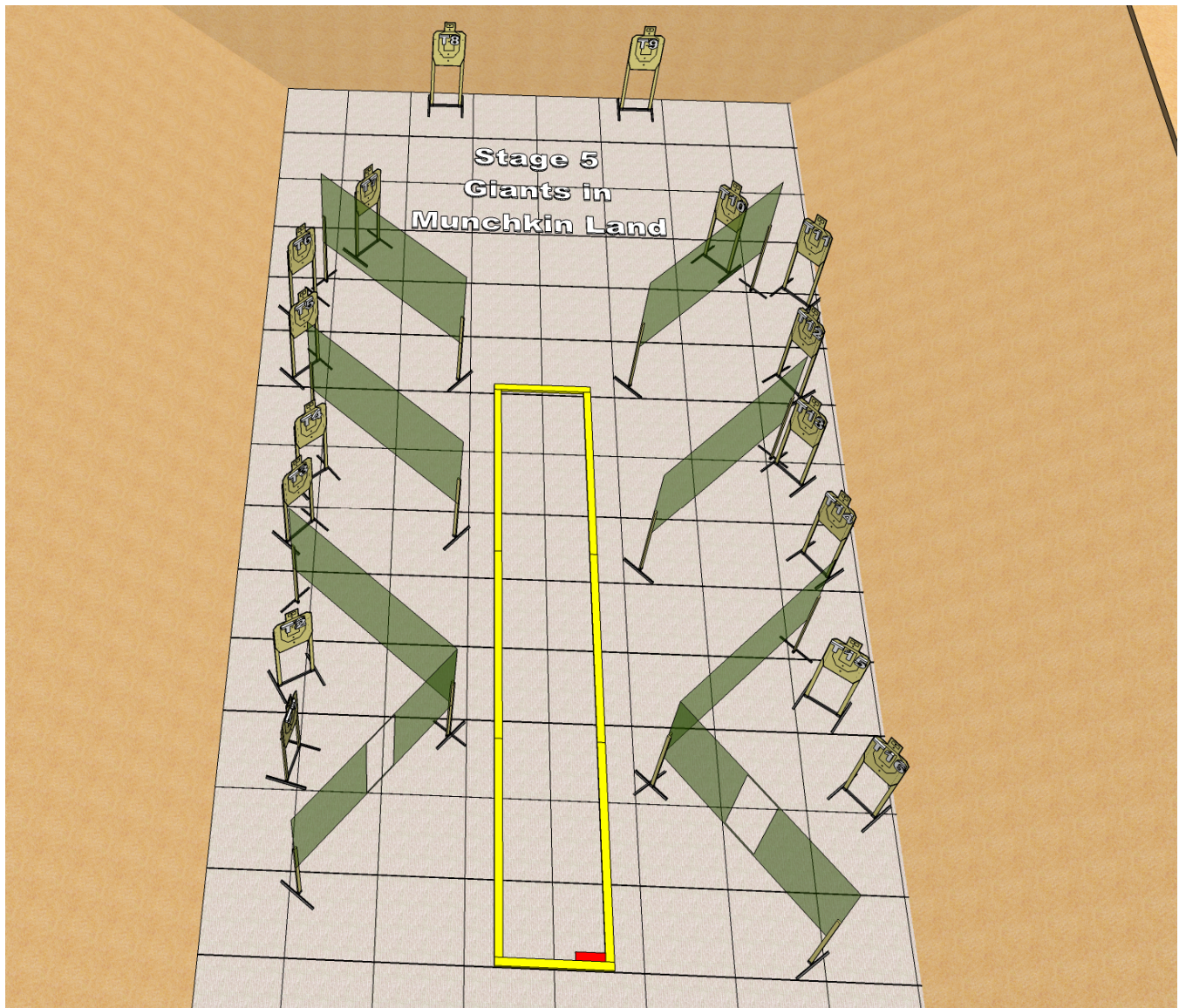
START POSITION: Standing with heels on Start Stick. Handgun is loaded and holstered.
PCC is loaded and held in both hands, with butt on belt and muzzle pointed safely downrange.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On start signal, engage T1-T16 with two (2) rounds each.

SCORING

SCORING: Virginia count, 32 rounds, 160 points
TARGETS: 16 USPSA
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per USPSA
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
Extra shot. -10
Extra hit. -10
Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: Use the grid (3' x 3') as a guide and eliminate any shoot throughs and/or 180's.

RO NOTES: Listen for extra shots.

Stage 6

Beginner's Options

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Bretton Rebol

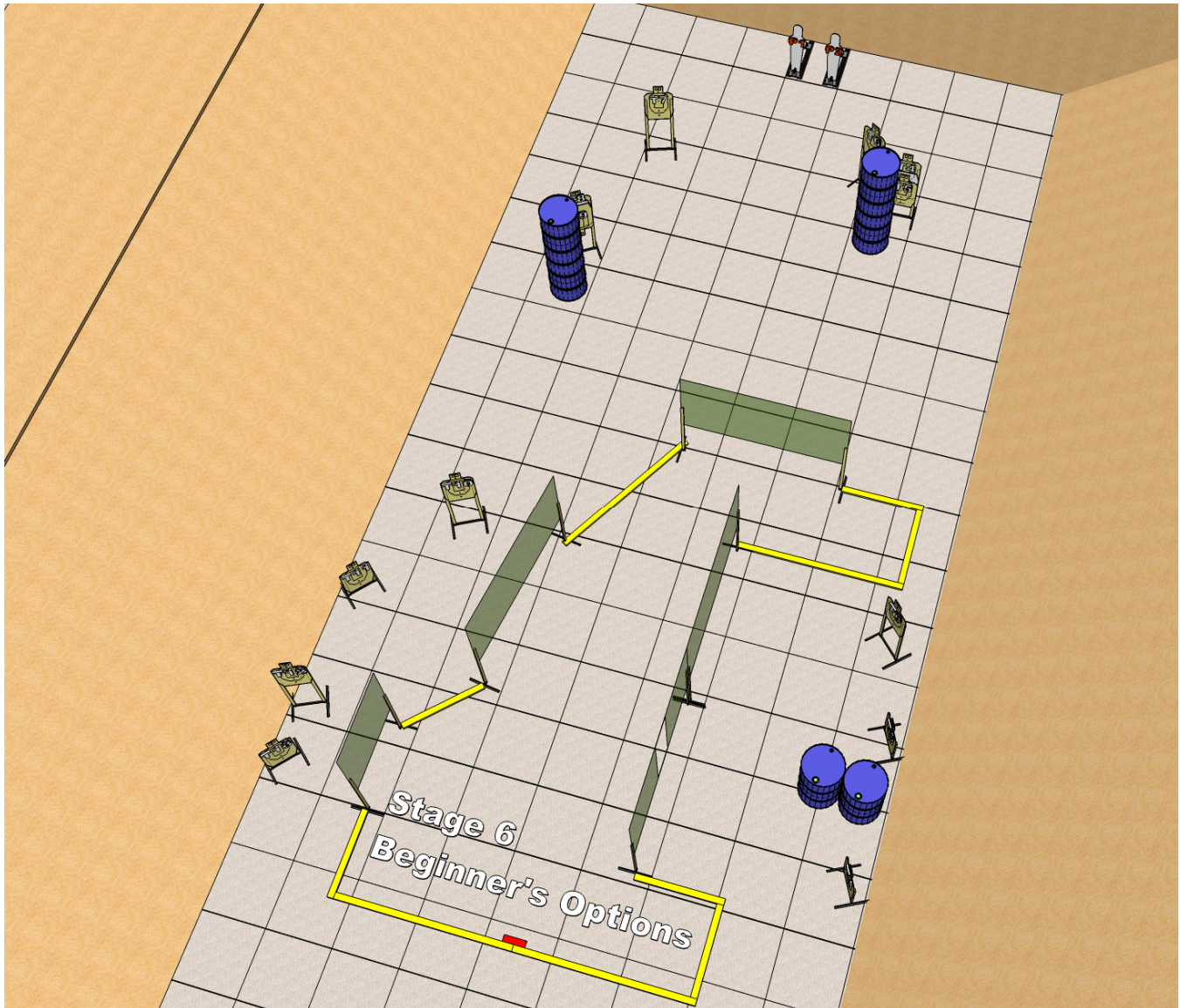
START POSITION: Standing with heels on Start Stick. Handgun is loaded and holstered.
PCC is loaded and held in both hands, with butt on belt and muzzle pointed safely downrange.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On start signal, engage T1-T13 with two (2) rounds each and knock down P1 & P2.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 28 rounds, 140 points
TARGETS: 13 USPSA, 2 Poppers
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per USPSA, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
No-shoot hit. -10
Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: T2 is only visible from the port. T4 & T5 are only visible from forward right shooting area. T5, T8 & T9 are only visible from the front left shooting area. Ensure T1 and T10-T13 are not visible beyond the 180.

RO NOTES: Watch for Foot Faults.
