Scoring: Comstock course of fire

Targets: 6 IPSC cardboard targets

Rounds: 12

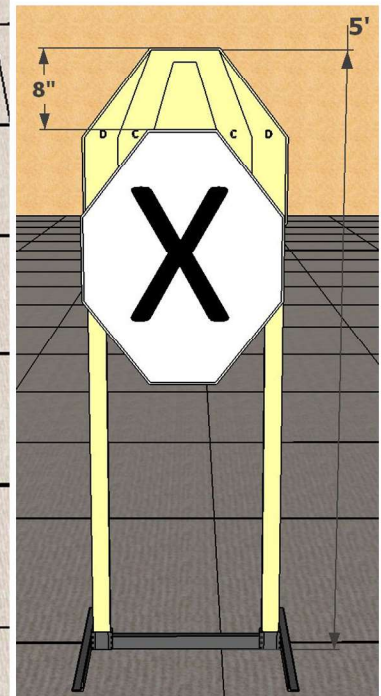
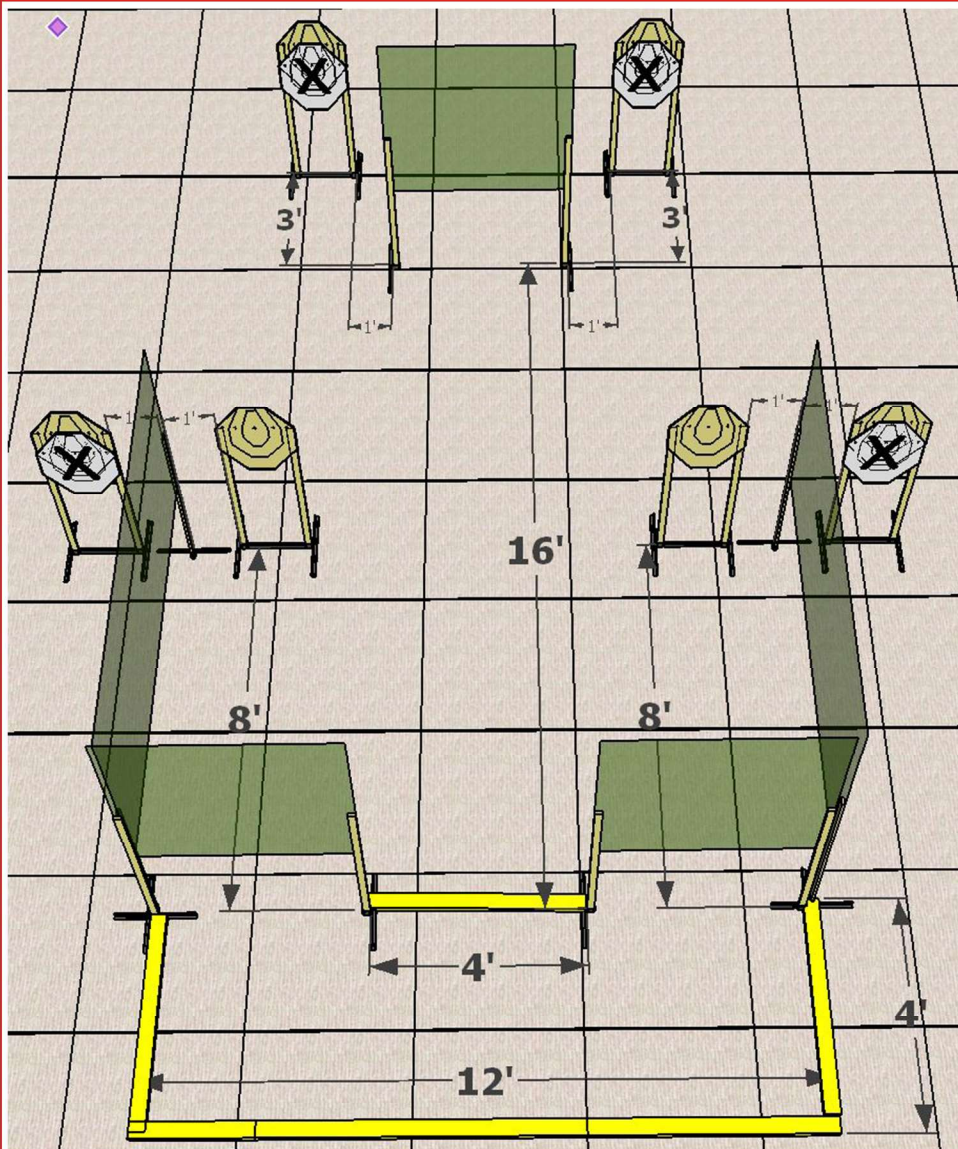
Condition: Loaded and holstered

Start Position: Feet touching downrange (front) fault line.

Handgun loaded and holstered, wrists below belt.

PCC loaded, stock on belt, safety on.

Procedure: : Upon audible start signal, engage targets from within the shooting area.

THS Short Course

Written Stage Briefing

THS Short Course is a 12 round, 60-point, Comstock Classifier course. There are 6 IPSC targets.

The handgun start position is feet touching downrange (front) fault line with handgun loaded and holstered and wrists below belt.

The PCC start position is feet touching downrange (front) fault line, PCC loaded with safety on, stock on belt, muzzle generally downrange.

On the audible start signal, engage targets as they become available from within the shooting area.



2 - Unload Yourself

Scoring: COMSTOCK, Best 2 hits on cardboard.

Targets: 12 USPSA targets

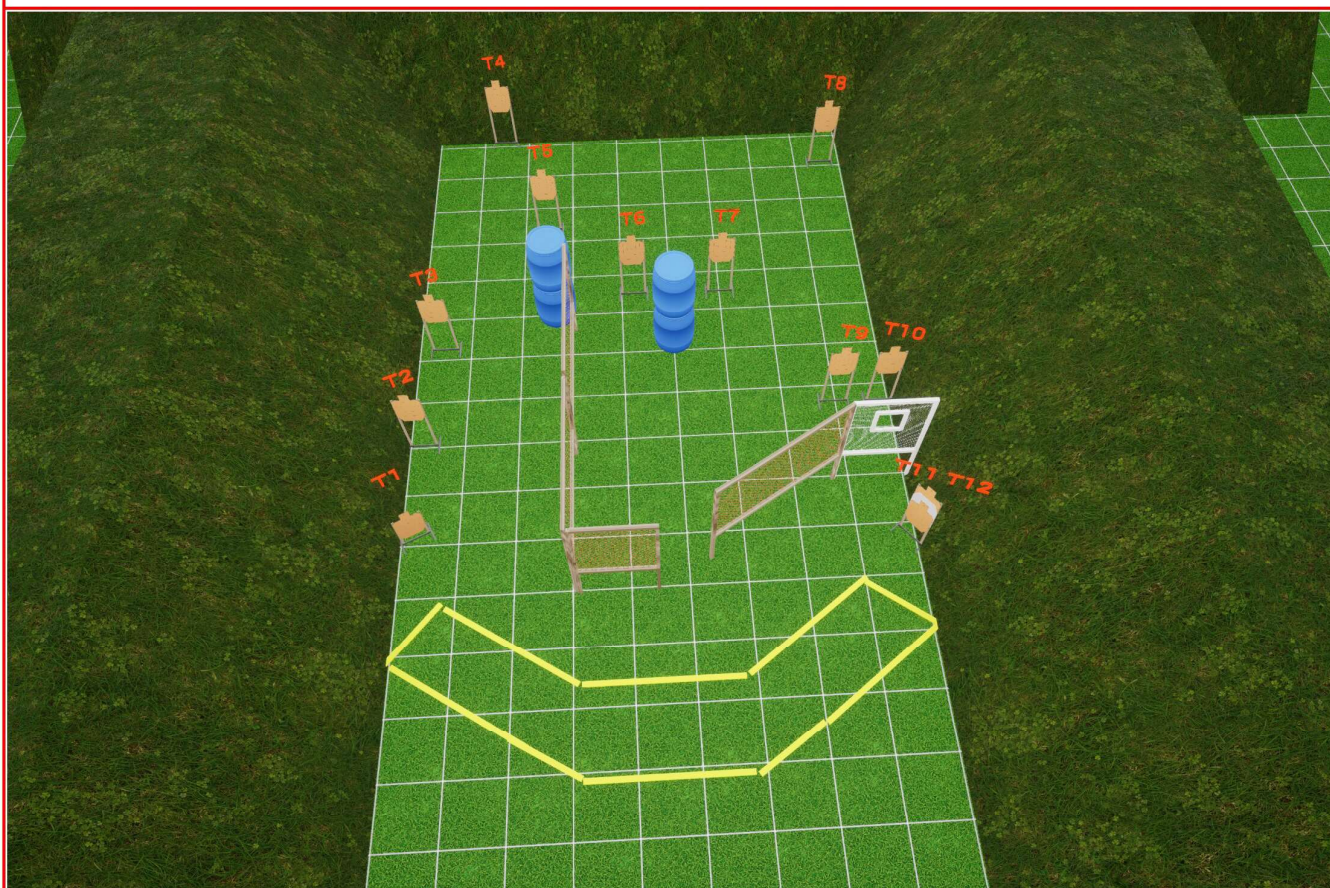
Rounds: 24

Start Position:

The start position is standing anywhere in the shooting area, facing down range with wrists below belt. Handgun is unloaded and holstered. PCC start position is unloaded, stock on belt, muzzle pointing downrange.

Procedure:

On the audible start signal, engage all targets from within the shooting area.

2 - Unload Yourself

WRITTEN STAGE BRIEFING

Welcome to stage 2 - Unload Yourself.

Unload Yourself is a 24 round, 120 point COMSTOCK Long course. There are 12 USPSA targets. The start signal is audible.

The start position is standing anywhere in the shooting area, facing down range with wrists below belt. Handgun is unloaded and holstered. PCC start position is unloaded, stock on belt, muzzle pointing downrange.

On the audible start signal, engage all targets from within the shooting area.

Targets: 12 USPSA targets

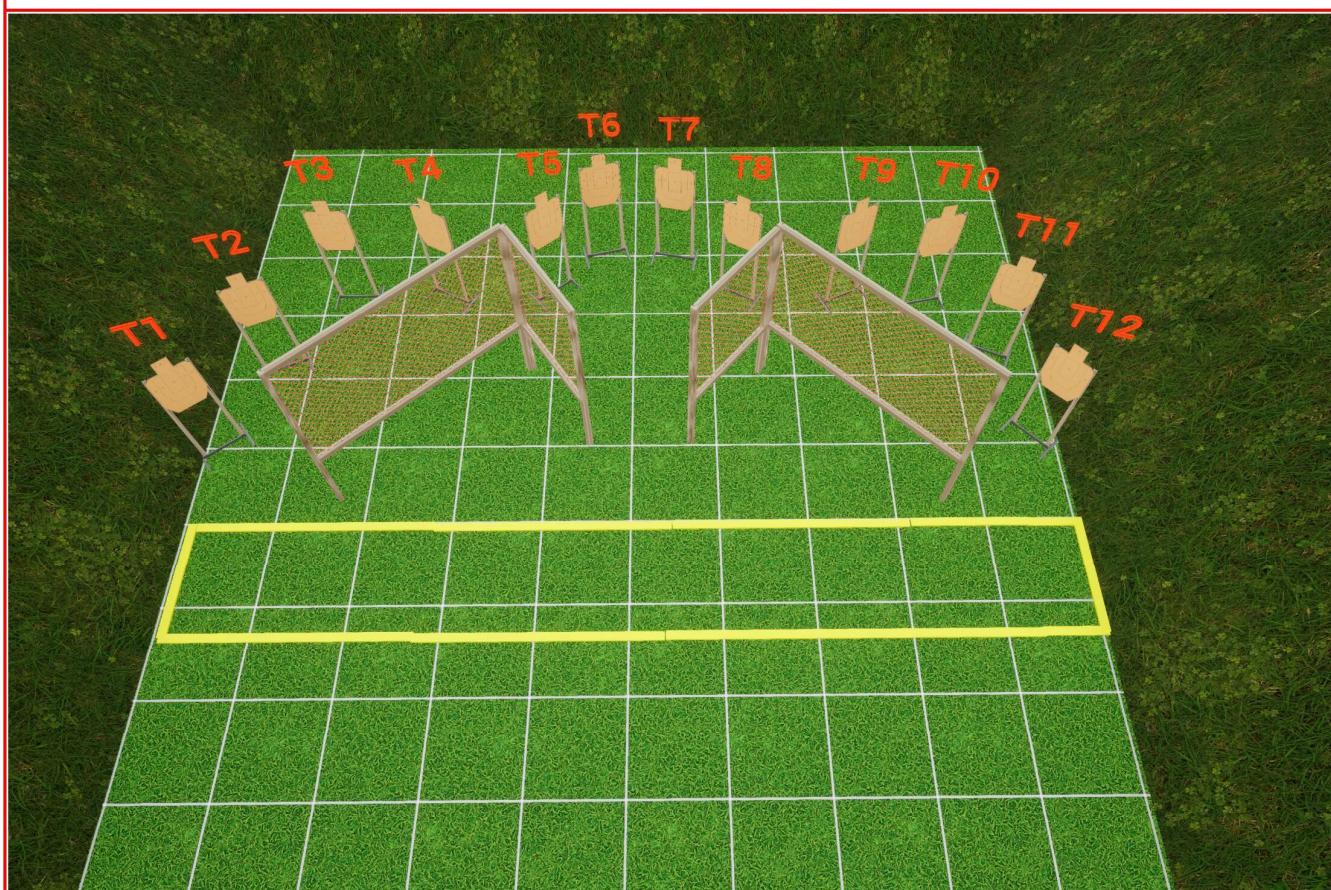
Rounds: 24

The start position is standing anywhere in the shooting area, facing down range with wrists below belt. Handgun is loaded and holstered. PCC start position is stock on belt, safety on, muzzle pointing downrange

On the audible start signal, engage all targets from within the shooting area.





4 - Just for Eddie

Scoring: COMSTOCK, Best 2 hits on cardboard.

Targets: 8 USPSA targets, 3 poppers

Rounds: 19

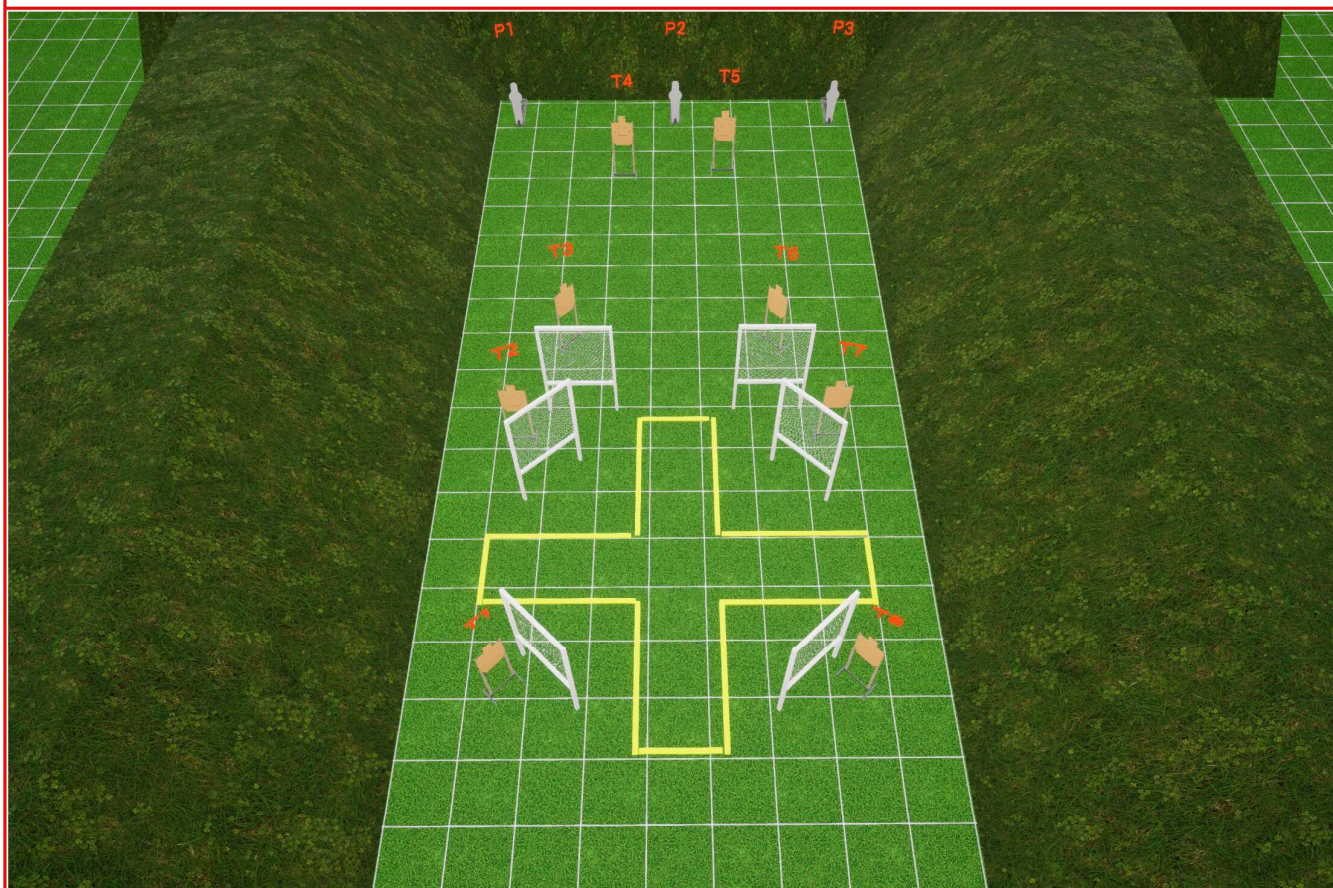
Start Position:

The start position is standing anywhere in the shooting area, facing down range with wrists below belt. Handgun is loaded and holstered. PCC start position is stock on belt, safety on, muzzle pointing downrange

Procedure:

On the audible start signal, engage all targets from within the shooting area.

You MUST stay within the Fault Lines for the entire course of fire (Rule 1.1.5.5).

4 - Just for Eddie

WRITTEN STAGE BRIEFING

Welcome to stage 4 - Just for Eddie.

Just for Eddie is a 19 round, 95 point COMSTOCK Medium course. There are 8 USPSA targets and 3 steel. The start signal is audible.

The start position is standing anywhere in the shooting area, facing down range with wrists below belt. Handgun is loaded and holstered. PCC start position is stock on belt, safety on, muzzle pointing downrange.

On the audible start signal, engage all targets from within the shooting area.

You MUST stay within the Fault Lines for the entire course of fire (Rule 1.1.5.5).





5 - Laid an Egg

Scoring: COMSTOCK, Best 2 hits on cardboard.

Targets: 2 USPSA targets, 6 poppers, 6 mini poppers

Rounds: 16

Start Position:

The start position is standing with palms flat on the Make Ready Table, facing down range. Firearm is loaded and placed on the Make Ready table.

Procedure:

On the audible start signal, retrieve firearm and engage all targets from within the shooting area.

5 - Laid an Egg

WRITTEN STAGE BRIEFING

Welcome to stage 5 - Laid an Egg.

Laid an Egg is a 16 round, 80 point COMSTOCK Medium course. There are 2 USPSA targets and 12 steel. The start signal is audible.

The start position is standing with palms flat on the Make Ready Table, facing down range. Firearm is loaded and placed on the Make Ready table.

On the audible start signal, retrieve firearm and engage all targets from within the shooting area.





6 - Tilting at Windmills

Scoring: COMSTOCK, Best 2 hits on cardboard.

Targets: 8 IPSC targets, 1 popper, 1 mini popper, 5 steel

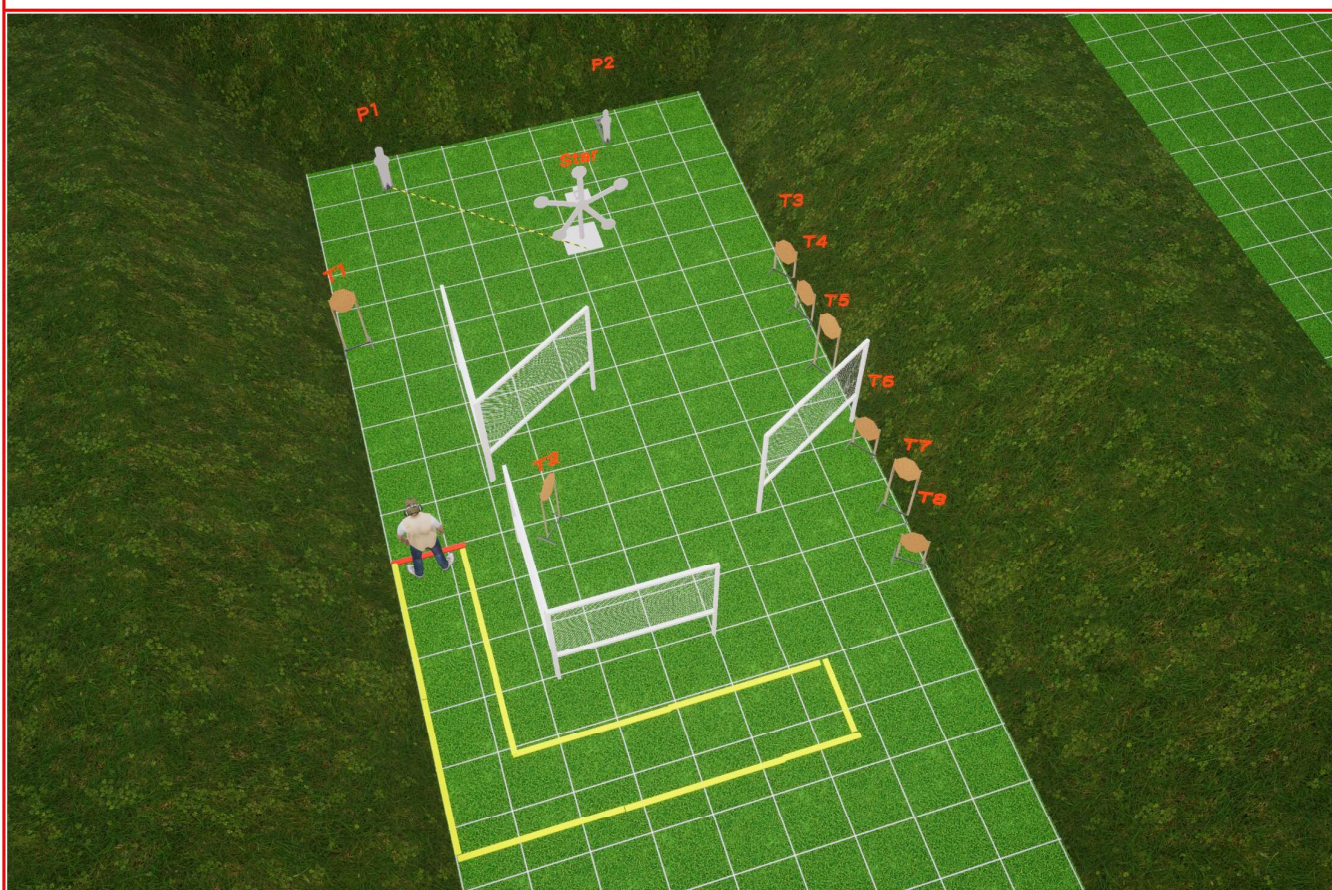
Rounds: 22

Start Position:

The start position is standing with both feet touching Start Stick, facing down range. Handgun is loaded and holstered. PCC start position is standing with both feet touching Start Stick, stock on belt, safety on, muzzle pointing downrange

Procedure:

On the audible start signal, engage all targets from within the shooting area.

6 - Tilting at Windmills

WRITTEN STAGE BRIEFING

Welcome to stage 6 - Tilting at Windmills.

Tilting at Windmills is a 22 round, 110 point COMSTOCK Medium course. There are 8 IPSC targets and 7 steel with 1 no-shoot target. The start signal is audible.

The start position is standing with both feet touching Start Stick, facing down range.

Handgun is loaded and holstered.

PCC start position is standing with both feet touching Start Stick, stock on belt, safety on, muzzle pointing downrange.

On the audible start signal, engage all targets from within the shooting area.

One Procedural for hitting the orange plate on the Texas Star.

USPSA Popper P1 activates the Texas Star. Failure to activate the Texas Star prior to engagement will incur one Procedural Penalty per plate knocked down prior to activation (Rule 9.9.4).
